

# Not Necessarily Irish!

## Another 9 1/2" Squares, Nine Ways Quilt

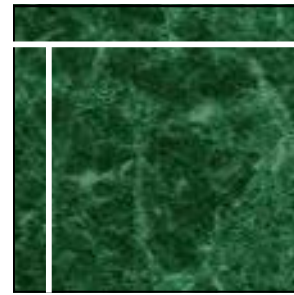
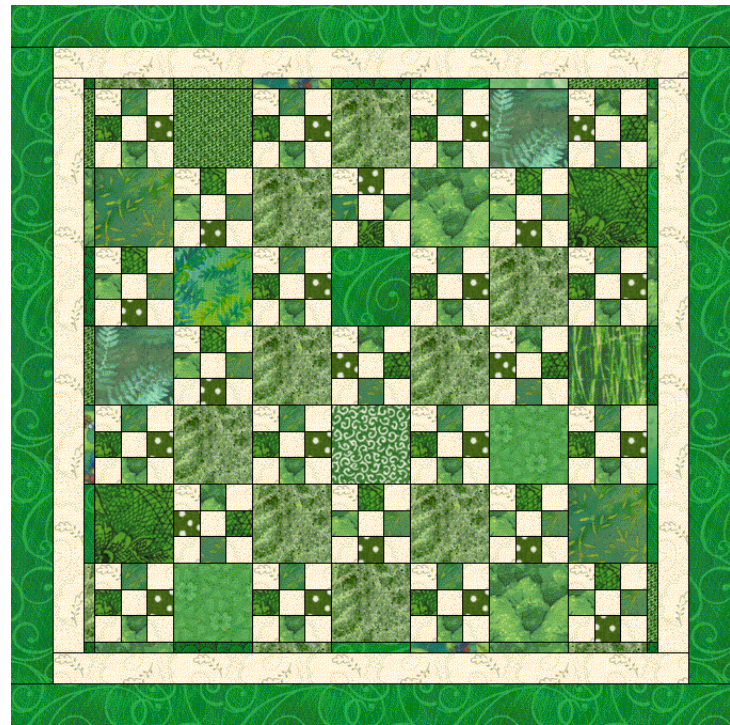
About 68" X 68"

1 3/4 yards White

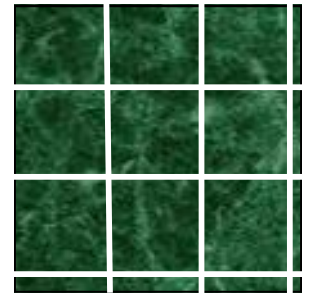
2 yards Green (inc. binding)

And a swap of 36 ea. 9 1/2" Green squares

1. Cut 24 of the Green squares to 8" square. Set aside 1 1/2" strips for inner border.
2. Cut 12 of the Green squares into 3" squares. Each 9 1/2" square should yield 9 ea. 3" squares for a total of 108.
3. From White fabric cut 125 ea. 3" squares (that's 10 ea. 3" WoF strips.)
4. Layout and stitch 25 9-Patches. Press to dark.
5. Row 1 starts with a 9-patch then alternates 8" squares and 9-patches, 7 across. Stitch 4 ea. Row 1s.
6. Row 2 starts with an 8" square then alternates 9-patches and 8" squares, 7 across. Stitch 3 ea. Row 2s.
7. Stitch all rows together to form center following diagram below.
8. Stitch 1 1/2" strips set aside in step 1 into a 57" length. Make 4. Use as inner border.
9. Inner White border is cut 3". (6 ea. WoF strips)
10. Outer Green border is cut 5". (8 ea. WoF strips)
11. Quilt as desired.
12. Bind with 8 ea. green 2 1/2" WoF Strips.

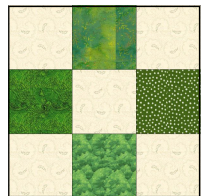


Cut 24 9 1/2" squares down to 8" squares. Save trimmings.

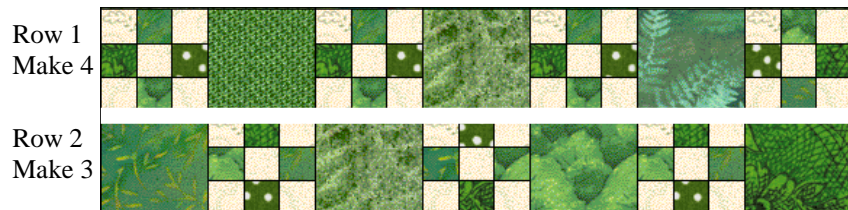


Cut 12 9 1/2" squares into 9 ea. 3" squares, total 108. Discard these trimmings.

Cut 10 ea. 3" WoF strips of White. Cut into 125 3" squares. Use 5 white squares and 4 green squares to stitch a 9-patch, 8" unfinished. Press to dark. Make 25.

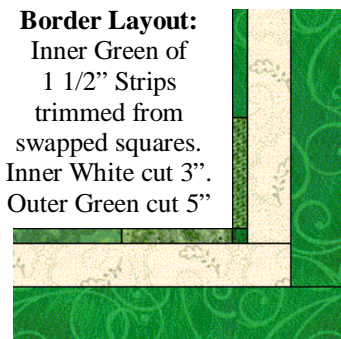


Quilt Center



### Border Layout:

Inner Green of 1 1/2" Strips trimmed from swapped squares.  
Inner White cut 3".  
Outer Green cut 5"
