







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

Background (Lt. Teal) 9 1/4 X 10 3/4" Binding: (Dk Brown) 2 1/2" X 42" Flange (Taupe) 2 @ 1" X 9 1/4"


Inverted Pocket: 9 1/4" X 5"

Prep for Applique: Two Bunnies (one and One Reversed)


Contrast is important when choosing fabrics. Also: 8" X 10" standing plexiglass frame.

Assembly:

- Use Cut-away fusible technique to adhere applique pieces on background.
- Stitch using 1-2 applique zigzag stitch.
- Layer with backing and batting.
- Quilt as desired.
- Fold flanges lengthwise, wrong sides together.
- Baste flanges in place, with a 1/8" seam, top and bottom first, then sides.
- Fold Pocket lengthwise wrong side together. Position at top edge on back of mini quilt, aligning top edge with raw edges and at sides.
- Baste in place with 1/8" seam..
- Add binding as usual, catching inverted pocket.
- Sign your name, date and town on the back and display over an 8" X 10" standing Plexiglass frame.





- Fold flanges lengthwise, wrong sides together.
- Baste flanges in place, with a 1/8" seam, top and bottom first, then sides.
- Fold Pocket lengthwise wrong side together. Position at top edge on back of mini quilt, aligning top edge with raw edges and at sides.
- Baste in place with 1/8" seam..
- Add binding as usual, catching inverted pocket.
- Sign your name, date and town on the back and display over an 8" X 10" standing Plexiglass frame.

- Fold Pocket lengthwise wrong side together. Position at top edge on back of mini quilt, aligning top edge with raw edges and at sides.
- Baste in place with 1/8" seam..
- Add binding as usual, catching inverted pocket.
- Sign your name, date and town on the back and display over an 8" X 10" standing Plexiglass frame.
