Binding: (Black) $21 / 2 " \mathrm{X} 42$ "
Flange (Pink)
2 @ 1"X 9 1/4"
2 @ 1" X $103 / 4 "$
Inverted Pocket:
$91 / 4 "$ X 5"

## Prep for Applique: Hearts

Contrast is important when choosing fabrics.
Also: 8 " $\times 10$ " standing plexiglass frame.

- Use Cut-away fusible technique to adhere pieces on background.
- Stitch using 1-2 applique zigzag stitch. Layer with backing and batting.
- Quilt as desired.
- Fold flanges lengthwise, wrong sides together.
- Baste flanges in place, with a $1 / 8$ " seam, top and bottom first, then sides.
- Fold Pocket lengthwise wrong side together. Position at top edge on back of mini quilt, aligning top edge with raw edges and at sides. - Baste in place with $1 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ seam..
- Add binding as usual, catching inverted pocket.
- Sign your name, date and town on the back and display over the 8 " X 10 " standing plexiglass frame.


## Leprechaun's Hat Mini Quilt



Cutting:
Background (Rust) 9 1/4 X 10 3/4"
Binding: (Green) $21 / 2 "$ X 42"
Flange (Black) 2 @ $1 "$ X 9 1/4" 2 @ 1" X 10 3/4"
Inverted Pocket: $91 / 4$ " X 5"
Prep for Applique: Shamrock (Cut hat away. Add Buckle of gold as shown in picture. Contrast is important when choosing fabrics. Also: 8 " X 10 " standing plexiglass frame.

- Use Cut-away fusible technique to adhere pieces on background.
- Stitch using 1-2 applique zigzag stitch. Layer with backing and batting.
- Quilt as desired.
- Fold flanges lengthwise, wrong sides together.
- Baste flanges in place, with a $1 / 8$ " seam, top and bottom first, then sides.
- Fold Pocket lengthwise wrong side together. Position at top edge on back of mini quilt, aligning top edge with raw edges and at sides. - Baste in place with $1 / 8$ " seam.. - Add binding as usual, catching inverted pocket.
- Sign your name, date and town on the back and display over an 8 " X 10 " standing plexiglass frame.

Background (Lt. Teal) 9 1/4 X 10 3/4"
Binding: (Dk Brown) $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ X 42"
Flange (Taupe) 2 @ 1 " X 9 1/4" 2 @ 1" X 10 3/4"
Inverted Pocket: $91 / 4$ " X 5"
Prep for Applique: Two Bunnies (one and One Reversed)
Contrast is important when choosing fabrics.
Also: 8" X 10" standing plexiglass frame.

## Assembly:

- Use Cut-away fusible technique to adhere applique pieces on background.
- Stitch using 1-2 applique zigzag stitch.
- Layer with backing and batting.
- Quilt as desired.
- Fold flanges lengthwise, wrong sides together.
- Baste flanges in place, with a $1 / 8$ " seam, top and bottom first, then sides.
- Fold Pocket lengthwise wrong side together. Position at top edge on back of mini quilt, aligning top edge with raw edges and at sides.
- Baste in place with $1 / 8$ " seam.
- Add binding as usual, catching inverted pocket.
- Sign your name, date and town on the back and display over an $8 "$ X $10 "$ standing Plexiglass frame.

Background (Lt. Blue) 9 1/4 X 10 3/4"
Binding: (Orange) $21 / 2 "$ X 42 "
Flange (Green) 2 @ 1 " X 9 1/4"
2 @ 1" X $103 / 4 "$
Inverted Pocket: $91 / 4$ " X 5"
Prep for Applique: Templates Provided Contrast is important when choosing fabrics. Also: 8 " X 10 " standing plexiglass frame.

## Assembly:

- Use Cut-away fusible technique to adhere applique pieces on background.
- Stitch using 1-2
applique zigzag stitch.

Layer with backing and batting.

- Quilt as desired.
- Fold flanges lengthwise, wrong sides together.
- Baste flanges in place, with a $1 / 8$ " seam, top and bottom first, then sides.
- Fold Pocket lengthwise wrong side together. Position at top edge on back of mini quilt, aligning top edge with raw edges and at sides.
- Baste in place with $1 / 8$ " seam..
- Add binding as usual, catching inverted pocket.
- Sign your name, date and town on the back and display over an 8 " X 10 " standing Plexiglass frame.
- Note: Pattern is reversed.

Flange (Orange) 2 @ 1" X 9 1/4"

2 @ 1" X 10
3/4"
Inverted Pocket: $91 / 4$ " X 5"
Prep for Applique: Pail, Handle, Shovel
Contrast is important when choosing fabrics.
Also: 8" X 10 " standing plexiglass frame.

Assembly:

- Use Cut-away fusible technique to adhere applique pieces on background.
- Stitch using 1-2 applique zigzag stitch.
- Layer with backing and batting.
- Quilt as desired.
- Fold flanges lengthwise, wrong sides together.
Baste flanges in place, with a $1 / 8$ " seam, top and bottom first, then sides.
- Fold Pocket lengthwise wrong side together. Position at top edge on back of mini quilt, aligning top edge with raw edges and at sides.
- Baste in place with $1 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ seam..
- Add binding as usual, catching inverted pocket.
- Sign your name, date and town on the back and display over an 8 " X 10 " standing Plexiglass frame.

Inverted Pocket:
$91 / 4 " \mathrm{X} 5$ "
Prep for Appignue:
Firecracker.(patriotic), Top (Red)
Optionalistars
(could be buttons)
Contrast is important when choosing fabrics.
Embroider Lines by hand or by machine.
Also: 8" X 10" standing plexiglass frame.
Assembly:

- Use Cut Away fusible technique to adhere applique pieces on background.
- Stitch using 1-2 applique zigzag stitch.
Embroider/Embellish as desired.
Layer with backing and batting.
Quilt as desired.
Fold flanges lengthwise, wrong sides together.
Baste flanges in place, with a $1 / 8$ " seam, top and bottom first, then sides.
- Fold Pocket lengthwise wrong side together. Position at top edge on back of mini quilt, aligning top edge with raw edges and at sides.
- Baste in place with $1 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ seam..
- Add binding as usual, catching inverted pocket.

Sky (Lt. Blue): 7 1/2" X 9 1/4
Grass: 3 3/4" X 9 1/4" (Stitch Sky/Grass together)
Binding:( Grass): $21 / 2$ " X 42 "
Flange (Dk Gray): 2 @ 1 " X 9 1/4" 2 @ 1 " $\mathrm{X} 103 / 4$ "

Inverted Pocket: 9 1/4" X 5" Prep for Applique:
Dark Gray, Medium Gray, Light Gray, Black
Contrast is important when choosing fabrics.
Also: 8" X 10 " standing plexiglass frame.
Assembly:
Use Cut-Away fusible technique to adhere applique pieces on background.

- Stitch using 1-2 applique zigzag stitch.
- Embroider/ Embellish as desired.
- Layer with backing and batting.
- Quilt as desired.
- Fold flanges lengthwise, wrong sides together.
- Baste flanges in place, with a $1 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ seam, top and bottom first, then sides.
- Fold Pocket lengthwise wrong side together. Position at top edge on back of mini quilt, aligning top edge with raw edges and at sides.
- Baste pocket in place with $1 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ seam.
- Add binding as usual, catching inverted pocket.

Background: Black or Blackboard print: 9 1/4 X 10 3/4"
Binding: (White or Pencil Print): $21 / 2$ " X 42 "
Flange (Gold): 2 @ 1 " X $91 / 4 "$ and 2 @ $1 "$ X $103 / 4 "$
Inverted Pocket: $91 / 4$ " X 5"
Prep for Applique:
Apple, Stem, Leaves, Worm. Optional Books (They run off the edge and are not entirely visible)
Contrast is important when choosing fabrics.
Also: 8 " X 10" standing Plexiglass frame.

## Assembly:

- Use Cut-Away fusible technique to adhere applique pieces centered on background.
- Embroider/Embellish/Ink Worm Face as desired.
- Layer with backing and batting.
- Quilt as desired.
- Fold Pocket lengthwise wrong side together. Position at top edge on back of mini quilt, aligning top edge with raw edges and at sides.
- Baste in place with $1 / 8$ " seam.
- Add binding as usual, catching inverted pocket.
- Sign your name, date and town on the back and display over an 8 " X 10 " standing Plexiglass frame.

Background: Sunset Batik: 9 1/4 X 10 3/4"
Binding: (Black): 2 1/2" X 42"
Flange (Orange): 2 @ 1" X 9 1/4" and 2 @ 1"X 10 3/4"
Inverted Pocket: 9 1/4" X 5"
Prep for Applique:
Scarecrow Silhouette (Black)
Contrast is important when choosing fabrics.
Also: 8" X 10" standing Plexiglass frame.

## Assembly:

- Use Cut-Away fusible technique to adhere applique pieces centered on background.
- Layer with backing and batting.
- Quilt as desired, appliquéing as you quilt.
- Fold Pocket lengthwise wrong side together. Position at top edge on back of mini quilt, aligning top edge with raw edges and at sides.
- Baste in place with $1 / 8$ " seam.
- Add binding as usual, catching inverted pocket.
- Sign your name, date and town on the back and display over the $8 "$ X $10 "$ standing Plexiglass frame.



# November Thankful Turkey Mini Quilt 

This fun turkey can have a body with the outline of your favorite child's hand. Trace their hand then add the wattle, beak and wing. Use a fabric for his body that reminds you of a turkey... Brownprints, rust prints, etc. Use a contrast, maybe gold or a darker shade of the body color for the wing. The wattle is red, the beak gold and use a French knot, a black bead or ink for the eye. The feet can be fabric or embroidery of ink.

## Cutting:

Background: Background: 9 1/4 X 10 3/4"
Binding: (Brown): 2 1/2" X 42"
Flange (Orange): 2 @ 1" X 9 1/4" and 2 @ 1" X 10 3/4"
Inverted Pocket: $91 / 4$ " X 5"
Prep for Applique: Turkey, Wing, Wattle, Beak
Contrast is important when choosing fabrics. Also: 8" X 10" standing Plexiglass frame.

Layer with backing and batting.

- Quilt as desired, appliquéing as you quilt.

Inverted Pocket: $91 / 4$ " X 5"
Prep for Applique: Polka Dots, Pot and Pot Lip
Contrast is important when choosing fabrics.
Also: 8 " $\times 10$ " standing Plexiglass frame.

## Assembly:

- Use Cut-Away fusible technique to adhere applique pieces centered on background.
- Layer with backing and batting.
- Quilt as desired, appliquéing as you
 quilt.
- Fold Pocket lengthwise wrong side together. Position at top edge on back of mini quilt, aligning top edge with raw edges and at sides.
- Baste in place with $1 / 8$ " seam.
- Fold Flanges in half lengthwise and
 catching inverted pocket and flange.
- Sign your name, date and town on the back and display over the 8 " X 10 "

Inverted Pocket: $91 / 4$ "X 5"
Prep for Applique:
Cupcake, Icing, Contrast, Candles, Flame
Contrast is important when choosing fabrics.
Also: 8" X $10 "$ standing Plexiglass frame.

## Assembly:

- Use Cut-Away fusible technique to adhere applique pieces centered on background.
- Layer with backing and batting.
- Quilt as desired.
- Fold Pocket lengthwise wrong side together. Position at top edge on back of mini quilt, aligning top edge with raw edges and at sides.
- Baste in place with $1 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ seam..
- Add binding as usual, catching inverted pocket.
- Sign your name, date and town on the back and display over an 8 " X 10 " standing Plexiglass frame.

Background (Pieced from 2 1/2" Batik scraps or a whole piece): 9 1/4 X 10 3/4"
Binding: (Black): $21 / 2$ " X 42 "
Inverted Pocket:
$91 / 4 "$ X 5"
Prep for Applique:
Bird and Branch: Black or Contrasting Batiks
Contrast is important when choosing fabrics.
If you use the black, you could thread paint with varie-
 gated thread over the applique following lines as shown in the sample below right.

Also: 8 " X 10" standing Plexiglass frame.


## Assembly:

- Use Cut-Away fusible technique to adhere applique pieces on background.
- Stitch using straight stitch for thread painting.
- Embroider/Embellish as desired.
- Layer with backing and batting.
- Quilt as desired.
- Fold Pocket lengthwise wrong side together. Position at top edge on back of mini quilt, aligning top edge with raw edges and at sides.
- Baste in place with $1 / 8$ " seam..
- Add binding as usual, catching inverted pocket.
- Sign your name, date and town on the back and display over an 8 " X 10 " standing Plexiglass frame.
