## The Microwave Baked Potato Bag

### Cutting:

- 2 ea. 22" X 10" Cotton Print (Bag Outside and Lining)
- 1 ea. 22" X 10" Warm and Natural Cotton Batting

### Assembly:

1. Place Print Rectangles Right Sides Together. Place batting rectangle on top.
2. Stitch all around, leaving a 4" opening at one short end to turn. Trim Corners. Turn, Press. Top Stitch that short end to close the opening.
3. Fold that short end up to about 2" of top having bag print showing. Press and top stitch all around to complete.
4. Make some as gifts... Be sure to tuck a copy of the directions for use (below) inside!
5. Change the rectangle sizes to make bags to warm tortillas or to cook corn on the cob!



1. Stitch All Around, Leave Opening



2. Clip Corners, Turn, Press, Top Stitch to Close



3. Fold up to 2" from Top, Stitch all around.

### Baked Potato Bag

This bag creates a baked potato that is perfect in your microwave oven. The inside of the potato is well done, yet moist, while the skin is tender. The bag will cook up to 4 medium size potatoes at one time. Wash and dry the potatoes. **DO NOT PRICK!!!** Wrap potatoes in paper towels and place in potato bag. Place in oven. Microwave as instructed by your manufacturer, usually 10 minutes. When serving cut open potatoes with a fork. Potatoes will be fluffy and so-o-o good! If necessary, let bag air dry.
