Welcome! My name is Lyn Brown and I teach Quilting. Now, this is a year-round class so we have projects going all the time. There are individual supply lists for those projects with fabric requirements as well as any special tools, etc.

This page is meant to give you the general supplies needed for this class... The things you should have on hand to make the projects we do.

General Supplies

- 1. **Sewing machine** in good working order. If you have troubles with your machine, please talk to me. I'm getting pretty good at minor repairs and might be able to help. We generally don't bring machines to class, but having one at home is a must!
 - a. Attachments:

1/4" foot. This is a special foot that has a distance of 1/4" from the needle to the edge of the foot. Necessary for machine piecing.

Walking foot. This contraption is essential for machine quilting.

Plus: A supply of bobbins, needles, good thread, oil, screwdriver.

- 2. **Rotary cutting equipment.** Rotary cutter (I like the Olfa brand),
 Rotary mat (at least 12" X 18"), and
 Rotary rulers (I like Omnigrid black and yellow rulers)
 in two sizes: 6" X 12" and 12 1/2" square.
- 3. **Basic sewing equipment.** Scissors: A good pair of shears and a small thread nippers. Straight pins, safety pins and hand needles in an assortment of sizes. Tape measure. Seam ripper (we all need one of these!) Any other supplies you think you'll need and a box to store it all in!

Welcome to our class! We have lots of fun and make lots of things. Always ask questions. Sometimes I go too fast and I'm always happy to go over something again. The important thing to me is that you learn and enjoy!
