Each month, reserve 7 light and 7 dark 8" squares
From our swaps or from your stash
Or from 2 light and 2 dark (minimum) Fat Quarters or similar scraps.




Fold For Guides

Layer, Stitch


To make 8 Half Square Triangle (HST) Units:


To make 8 ea. 3" finished HSTs, cut two squares to be 7 3/4" squares OR Start with 8" swap squares and trim afterwards... This is slightly more accurate.

- 1. Fold or mark the lighter color fabric square on both diagonals as a guide.
- 2. Layer one dark square with the light square RST.
- 3. Stitch 1/4" on both sides of both diagonals.
- 4. Cut stitched squares in half parallel to the edges. Then cut on the diagonals. This yields 8 ea. Half Square Triangle units.
- 5. Trim units to 3 1/2" unfinished size if necessary.
- 6. Stitch the triangle units into pairs with the same orientation of light and dark. Make 28 pairs.
- 7. Stitch the pairs into 4-Patch type units.
- 8. Make 14 each 6 1/2" 4-Patch units.









Repeat this process each month in the color of the month. At the end of 2012 you will have the makings of the Fabulous Rainbow Triangles Quilt!
