

# Scattered Hearts Doll Quilt/Table Topper

We've been talking in class about how to use the leftover bits of swap fabric when making the [Scattered Hearts](#) quilt.

*For your Large Quilt, first cut a 3 1/2" Vertical strip (trim to 6 1/2" X 3 1/2").*

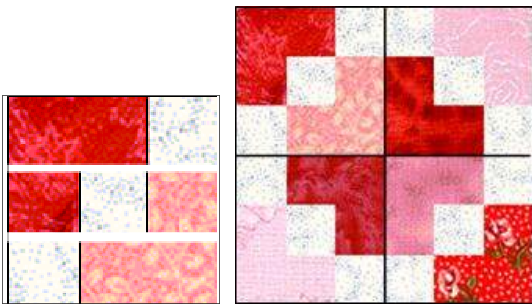
*Then make a Horizontal 3 1/2" cut (trim to 3 1/2" X 3 1/2").*

*That leaves the 4 1/2" square to use for this Doll Quilt/Table Topper!*

After cutting the 3 1/2" X 6 1/2" piece and the 3 1/2" square as shown above from our 8" swap squares you will have fabric enough in that remaining 4 1/2" square to cut a 2" x 3 1/2" piece and a 2" square from each as well. Or you can just make this doll/topper quilt from a selection of 5" charm squares. (48 or 28 charm squares and a half yard of background fabric, half yard of pink for border and a half yard of red for inner border and binding.)

You can use these pieces (with 3 ea. 2" squares of background fabrics) to make doll quilt sized blocks that are 4 1/2" finished, 5" unfinished. Use these blocks to make 9" Great "Doll Blocks" as shown in the original [Scattered Hearts Quilt PDF](#).

Use 1 1/2" x 9 1/2" sashes for the rows and 21 1/2" x 1 1/2" sashes between the rows. The top and bottom sashing is cut 19 1/2" x 1 1/2" and will be set with 1 1/2" red squares on both short ends. The red inner sides border will be cut 31 1/2" x 1 1/2". The top and bottom red border will be cut 21 1/2" and will be set with 1 1/2" pink squares on both short ends.

The last pink borders will be cut 33 1/2" x 3 1/2" for the sides and 29 1/2" x 3 1/2" for the top and bottom. The final size of the Doll Quilt/Table Topper will be about 29 x 39.

Of course you could reduce the number of great blocks to four and end up with a 29" square Doll/Topper.

Either size would be fun and easy to make!
