The "Mysterious" Applique Border

I am in process of designing this border so I can't even share a pic with you. I can tell you my first mock up is just wonderful. I am going to finish putting this together at my quilting retreat this week and will have the complete pattern and instructions for you next Sunday March 18.

Here are the cutting dimensions of the background for the border. We are going to miter this border after doing the appliqué so we'll need to take that into account. Don't worry about the mitering, two foolproof methods will be presented so you are sure to be successful.

There four border pieces to be cut from the Background fabric. They have a calculated cut size of 40 1/2" x 6 1/2" BUT because we are going to be placing applique on these pieces we need them cut at least **41" x 7"**. I'm thinking 7" width of fabric strips will be just fine. So, as long as your background fabric is at least 42", cut **4 each 7" x WoF** from your background, trim off the selvages and press in half both ways to mark a guide then check back here (LynBrown.com) next Sunday (3/18) for that mysterious appliqué.
