

Little Boys' Toys

(21" X 26")

Supplies:

Background/Border (White): 1 yard
 Sails (Blue): 1/4 yard
 Boat and Binding (Red): 1/2 yard
 Sashing (Yellow): 1/4 yard

Cutting:

From Background:

24 ea. 2" X 3 1/2"
 3 ea. 5" Square
 24 ea. 2" Square
 4 ea. 2 1/2" X 23" (just a bit oversized)

From Sails:

12 ea. 2" Squares
 20 ea. 1 1/4" Squares (Cornerstones)
 3 ea. 5" Squares

From Boat and Binding:

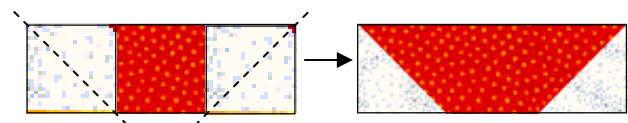
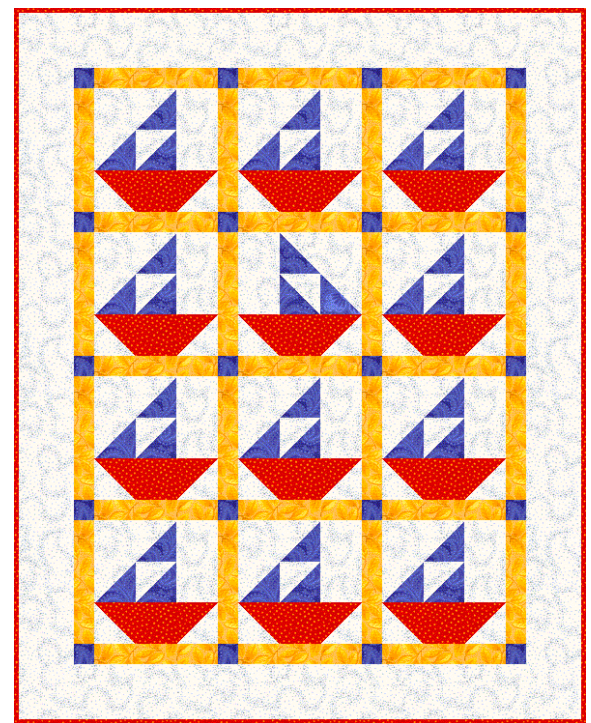
12 ea. 2" X 5"
 3 ea. 2" X Width of Fabric

From Sashing:

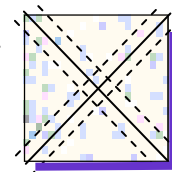
31 ea. 5" X 1 1/4"

Assembly:

1. Boat: Snowball a Background 2" Square onto both short sides of the Boat 2" X 5" to make boat (See right). Make 12 Boats.
2. Sails Part 1: Draw/Press both diagonals on the 3 lighter 5" squares. Layer a Background and a Sail 5" Square right sides together. Stitch 1/4" on both sides of each diagonal. Cut 2 1/2" in from the sides (along centers) then on the diagonals. Make 3 sets to yield 24 half square triangles. Trim the HSTs to 2". Stitch two triangles together as shown in A at right. Make 11. Stitch another pair together as in B at right for rogue block. Stitch a Background 2" X 3 1/2" to each along the dark side of the triangles as shown.
3. Sails Part 2: Following diagram at right, snowball one Sail 2" square onto 2" X 3 1/2" Background to form another sail. Make 11 and one reversed as shown for rogue block.
4. Assemble the Block: Following diagram at right assemble sail section. Then add that to the boat portion to complete the block, remembering to make that one rogue block. Blocks should be 5".
5. Add Ls of Sashings and Cornerstones: Follow the method on the next sheet to assemble blocks in this fashion.
6. Add borders to the sides then to the top and bottom, trimming the length to fit your quilt.
7. Layer and quilt as desired.



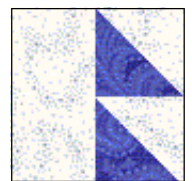

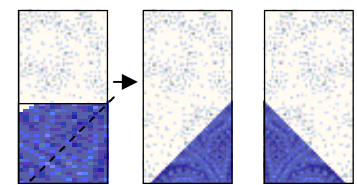

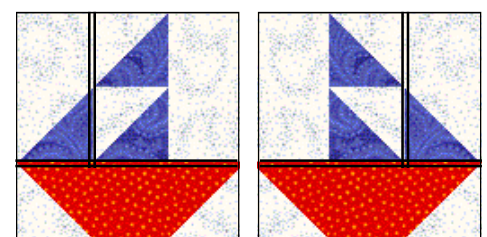
