## Spring Medallion

## **Twisted Ribbon Border**

Be sure your Spring Medallion Quilt Center measures about 40 1/2" square.

## **Cutting:**

	Background (Blue)A		10 ea.	5 1/4" squares	Cut on Both Diagonals
		В	2 ea.	4 7/8" squares	Cut on One Diagonal Only
7	Light: (Pink)	А	10 ea.	5 1/4" squares	Cut on Both Diagonals
		В	2 ea.	4 7/8" squares	Cut on One Diagonal Only
	Dark: (Green)	В	20 ea	4 7/8" squares	Cut on One Diagonal Only

## Assembly:

- Stitch together one Background A and one Light A as shown at right. Be sure to match the orientation. Press to <u>Light</u>. Make 40.
- 2. Add a Dark B as shown to complete the block. Make 40 ea. 4 1/2" Twisted Border Blocks.
- 3. Stitch together two Step 2 Blocks into a pair, watching orientation as at right. Make 20 pairs.
- 4. Stitch 5 of the pairs into a Border Strip as below. Make 4 Border Strips.
  - Stitch a strip on to the left side of your quilt top, using the border aroun
- 5. Stitch a strip on to the left side of your quilt top, using the border around this page as a guide for orientation. In the same way, add a strip to the right side of your quilt top.
- 6. For the corners, stitch together a Background B and Light B to make a Half Square Triangle Block. Make 4 ea. 4 1/2" HST Corner Blocks.
- 7. Lay out your top and the two remaining borders. Again using the border of this sheet as a guide, add the HST Blocks to the short edge of each border then add the borders to the top and bottom of your quilt top. The quilt top should now measure about 48 1/2".

**NOTE:** If desired, you can play with your blocks to create a different design. One possibility is shown at right. This has all the blocks oriented in the same way, with the dark edge against the quilt center and whole squares in the corners.
