Spring Medallion

Adding The Pieced Scallop Blocks To The Quilt


Last week we made 36 Pieced Scallop blocks. These blocks should measure 6 3/4" unfinished and your quilt top, after the Spacer Border, should measure 50 1/2".

To add this border to the quilt:

1. Set four blocks aside for the corners.

2. Stitch the remaining 32 blocks into 16 pairs, being sure to turn

one of the blocks 90 degrees or one quarter turn as shown at right. 3. Now stitch the pairs into quartets then into sets of eight for each border, always watching the orientation. Make 4 the same.





4. Add one border to the left and one to the right side of the quilt with orientation as pictured.

5. Add the set aside blocks to the ends of remaining borders, <u>orientation as shown</u>. Add these to top and bottom of quilt.

6. Quilt should now measure 63" square.
