64" Square * So Easy It's Criminal

Supplies:

1/2 Yard each of 3 Different Colors PLUS 1 1/4 Yard of a Fourth Color... Could be solids or semi solids or textural fabrics. Classmembers: Could be our 8" swap squares for variety.
3 Yards Background (White)

Cutting:

From EACH Color A, B, C, D:

9 ea. 4 1/2" Square

9 ea. 2 1/2" X 6"

9 ea. 2 1/2" X 8"

From D Only:

8 ea. 2 1/2" X Width of Fabric (Binding)

From Sashing/Border (White):

From Length: (Cut First)

2 ea. 3" X 50 1/2" (Sashing)

2 ea. 7" X 50 1/2" (Side Border)

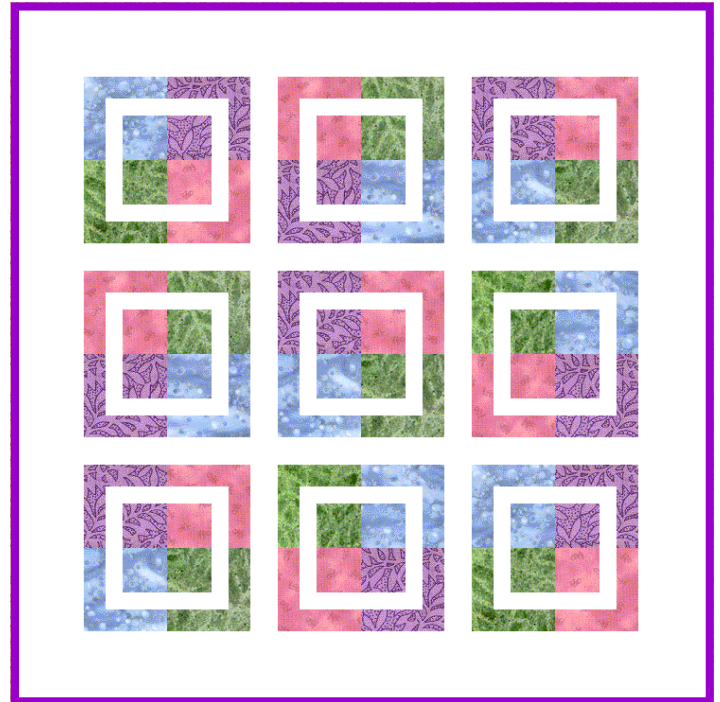
2 ea. 7" X 64 1/2" (Top/Bottom Border)

From Remaining White:

18 ea. 2" X 8 1/2"

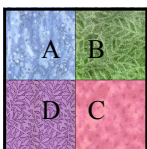
18 ea. 2" X 11 1/2"

6 ea. 3" X 15 1/2" (Sashing)

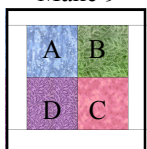
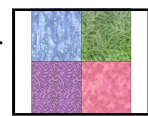


Assembly:

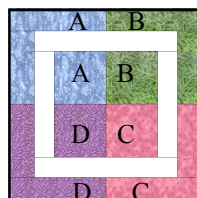
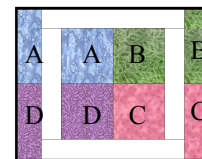
1. Using one 4 1/2" square of each color, make 4-Patches. Make 9 all the same.
2. Add the 2" X 8 1/2" White strips at the sides of the 4-Patches.
3. Add the 2" X 11 1/2" White strips at the top and bottom of the 4-Patches.
4. Stitch together a Fabric A and a Fabric D 2 1/2" X 6" strip along 2" side. Make 9. Add to left side of the Step 2 unit. Make 9. In a similar manner, stitch together a Fabric B and Fabric C 2 1/2" X 6" strip. Stitch to right side of Step 3 unit. Make 9.
5. Stitch together a Fabric A and a Fabric B 2 1/2" X 8" Strip. Stitch to the top of the Step 4 Unit. Stitch together a Fabric D and a Fabric C 2 1/2" X 8" Strip. Stitch to the bottom of the Step 4 Unit to complete block.
6. Turning each block randomly, stitch blocks together into three rows of three blocks with the 3" X 15 1/2" Sashing between. Stitch the rows together into the quilt center with the 3" X 50 1/2" Sashing between.
7. Add the Side Borders, then the Top/Bottom Borders to complete the quilt.
8. Layer and quilt as desired.
9. Bind with 2 1/2" Binding Strips of Fabric D. Enjoy!
