

Hummingbird Doll Quilt

20" X 24": 20 ea. 4" Blocks

Supplies: Background: 1/2 yard (Quilt A, B or C)
 Border/Block: 1/3 yard (A) Or 3/4 Yd (B) or 1/2 Yd (C)
 Binding/Blocks: 1/3 yard (A) Or 3/4 Yd (B) or 1/2 Yd (C)
 Block Scraps: 18 various 5" Squares or equivalent (A)
 OR 2 different 1/8 yards (C)



Cutting:

Background: 20 each 4 1/2" Squares
 (Or a bit larger then trim to 4 1/2" after applique is complete)
 Borders: 4 ea. 2 1/2" X 20 1/2"
 Binding: 3 ea. 2 1/4" strips


Prep for Applique your favorite way.... 80 Wings (one quarter of design below) Template given is for fusing. To hand applique, add seam allowances. Be sure to mix in fabrics from borders and binding as desired.

Assembly:


1. Applique the blocks with four Wings... Fold the Background square twice in half to find center. Following diagram below, fuse the Wings in place. Stitch down using a small (1 length and 2 width) zigzag or as desired. Trim block to 4 1/2" if needed. Make 20 blocks.
2. Stitch the blocks together into 5 rows of 4 blocks.
3. Add borders to the sides first, then to top and bottom to complete Hummingbird Doll Quilt Top.
4. Layer with backing and batting. Quilt as desired. Stitch in the ditch around the design is suggested as a minimum.
5. Bind with 2 1/4" Strips.
