

# Sunset And Vine Mystery

## Clue Nine

### *The Premiere*

These blocks remind me of the stars along Hollywood Blvd.  
So we came up with the name: **Sunset And Vine!**

*All that is left is to set the blocks together  
and add the borders.*

**Setting the blocks together is easy...**

1. Press your blocks and be sure the blocks measure 12 1/2".
2. The blocks always alternate between the 4-Patch block and the Star block.
3. Make three rows of five blocks that start and end with a 4-Patch.
4. Make two rows of 5 blocks that start and end with a Star block.
5. Assemble the rows with the 4-Patch started rows are the first, third and fifth rows and the Star started rows are the second and fourth rows as shown.
6. The quilt center should measure 60 1/2" square.

**Next add the Borders:**

**Cut/Assemble:**

Inner Border (Light Lead): 2 at 2 1/2" x 60 1/2" AND 2 at 2 1/2" x 64 1/2"

Outer Border (Medium Lead): 2 at 6" x 64 1/2" AND 2 at 6" x 75 1/2"

Binding (Medium Lead): 8 Strips 2 1/2" X Width of Fabric

1. Add the inner border then the outer border. Using good border techniques.
2. Layer with Backing and Batting. Quilt as Desired. Add Binding of the 2 1/2" Medium Lead Strips.
3. Enjoy!
