Cutting:




From Supporting Player (DARK Background!)

6 ea. 4 1/2" Width of Fabric Strips


Then Subcut 52 ea. 4 1/2" Squares

Assembly:


1. Stitch a Stand-Out and Dark Lead 4 Patch (Clue 5) to one of the 4 1/2" squares, watching orientation as at right. Make 26.
2. Add a Light and Medium Lead 4-Patch (Clue 3) to the 4 1/2" square side of the Step 1 units, watching orientation as at right. Press to the 4 1/2" Square. Make 26 Row A.
3. Stitch a Light and Stand-Out 4 Patch (Clue 5) to one of the 4 1/2" squares, watching orientation as at right. Make 13.
4. Add another 4 1/2" square on the opposite side as shown. Press to the 4 1/2" squares. Make 13 Row Bs.
5. Stitch a Row A to a Row B as shown, watching orientation. Make 13.
6. Add another Row A to the bottom of the block to complete. Press to Row B. Make 13.




