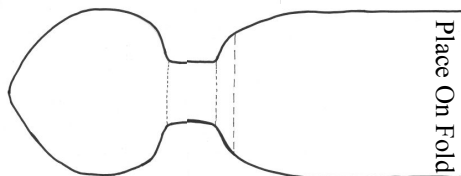


# Carol's Loopy Scarf

This great little scarf is simple to make and so warm and cozy to wear! What a Great Gift! You'll need to trace the template, overlapping at the longer dashed line as shown, onto Freezer Paper. Fold a 6" X 28" strip of fleece in half and place the FP template at the fold. Cut around Template carefully.

Also cut the Loop Rectangle. Place in position as shown over the smaller dashed line area on one end of scarf only. Machine or hand stitch in place along "X"ed line..



## To Wear...

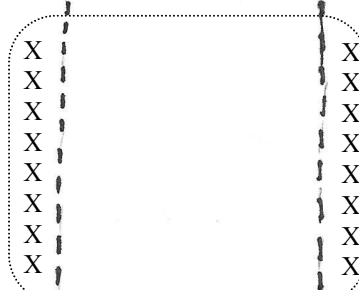
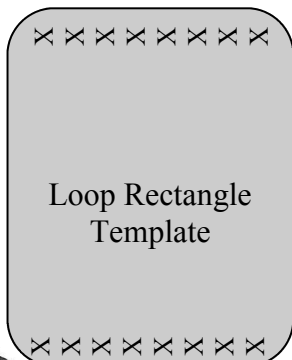
Just wrap around neck and pull opposite end through loop.

### Options:

Double up on the fleece and top-stitch the two layers together, stitching across the small dashed lines and leaving open between as the loop...

### OR....

With one (or two!) layers, Hand Buttonhole Stitch all around and hand stitch the Loop Rectangle in place as well...
