

# T-Shirt Scarf

8" X 70"

## Supplies:

2 yards of Cotton T-Shirt knit

Scraps for Appliqué

Paper-Backed Fusible Web (HeatNBond Lite)

## Cutting:

Cut from length 10" X 72" (You should get 5 scarves from one 2 yard length)

Prep for appliqué:

Templates given or from your own pattern

## Assembly:

1. Appliqué Snake or Bird And Branch (or other appliqué), centered, on one short edge of scarf piece, watching orientation and following diagram at right. Appliqué Diamonds or Leaves (or other) on other short end, being sure they are on the correct face of the scarf (same side as snake but opposite end.)

2. Fold the long edges of scarf under a scant one-half inch, pressing as you go. Press under again, this time a full half inch and pin as necessary. Stitch with matching thread.

3. In the same manner, turn under the short edges twice and stitch to complete your scarf. That is it! Enjoy... Stay warm and fashionable!



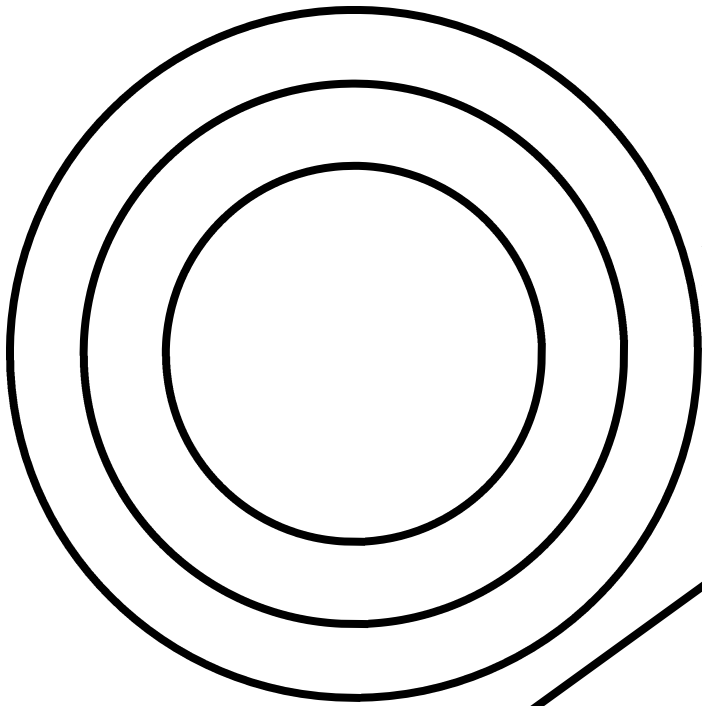
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## Lollipop Flower Scarf
