

Quilter's Alphabet Quilt

Block 49 "Yummy Yellow YoYos"

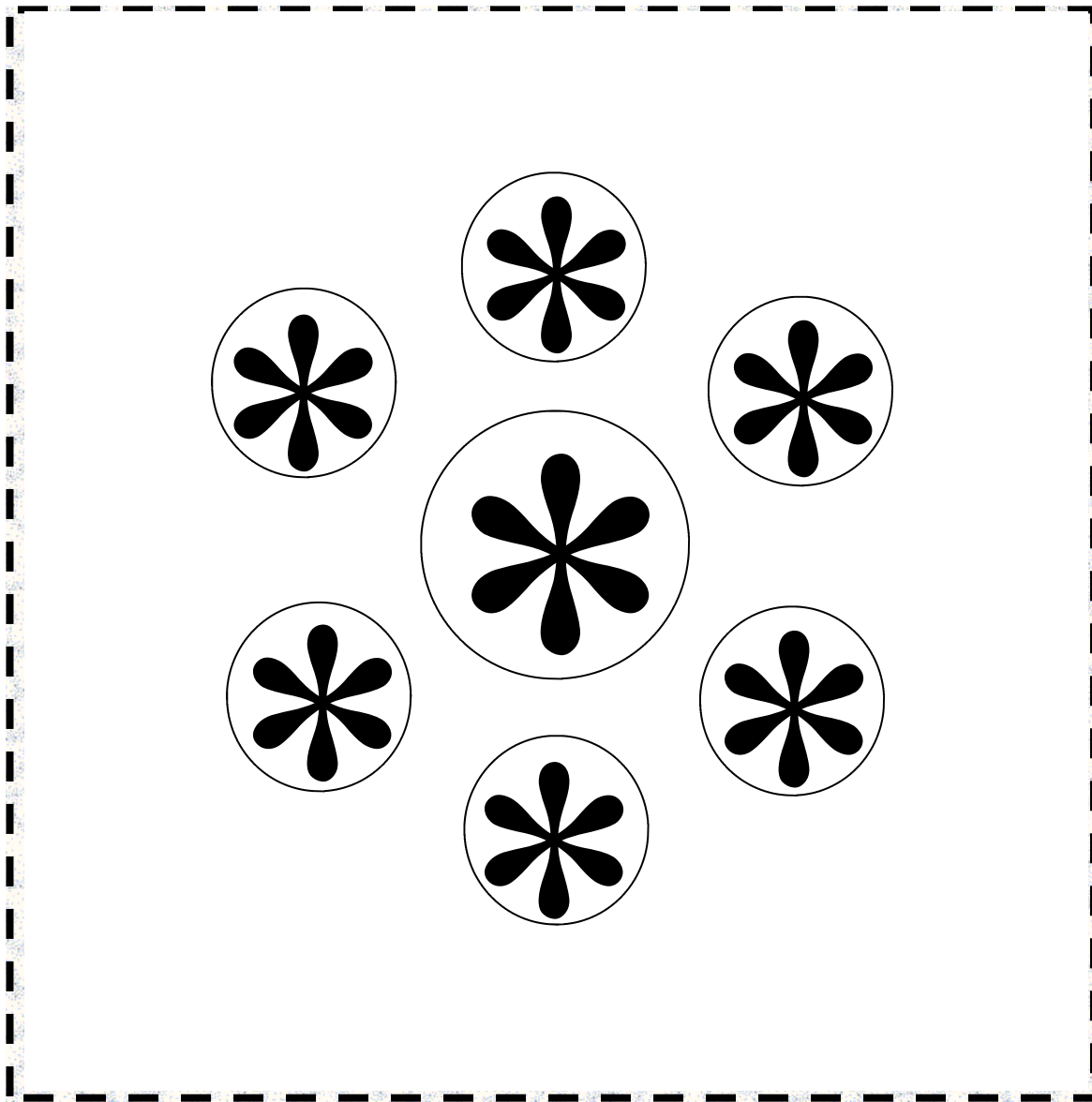

Block Finishes at 6". Cut Background 7".

Applique, centered, then trim background to 6 1/2".



We'll do the YoYos a bit differently, adding a bit of fusible to hold them in place while we stitch them to the block. Start with a circle of fusible (Paper Backed Fusible Web) and a larger circle of yellow fabric. Fuse PBFW dot to the center RIGHT side of fabric. Turn over the edge of the fabric circle with a double thread and a long gathering stitch to make yoyo. Gather thread, tie off and flatten into a circle. Make 7- 6@ 2 1/2", 1@ 3 1/2" circles of different yellows and 3/4" to 1 1/4" of PBFW circles respectively. Remove paper and iron in place on block. Stitch around edges by hand or machine with matching thread. *Yummy Yellow YoYos! Yahoo!*



Finished Size of Block. Please Add Seam Allowance To Background.

Be sure this printed block measures 6" before beginning!
