Fanciful Floral FourSquare

(64" X 79")

The Fanciful Floral FourSquare quilt consists of 12 ea. 12" Great Blocks
All are Floral Wreaths with Fanciful Flowers
Representing the Calendar Months

The quilt is presented for Fusible Machine Applique
but is also appropriate for hand appliqué if desired.

You will need to add seam allowance to all appliqué pieces if doing needleturn appliqué.

Each of the Great Blocks will consist of 4 ea. 6 1/2" blocks
(Our Blocks of the Week).

Supply List

To make this quilt, you will need:

2 1/2 yards Pastel/Light Background
(Use multiple backgrounds if you wish,
3 different but similar: 1/2 yard each plus
Another for Blocks, Sashing
and Inner Border: 1 1/2 Yards)

At Least 6 Different Quarter Yards/Large Scraps
Of Each Of These Color(s):

These can be Tone On Tones or Wild Prints
(I'm thinking about using Kaffe Fassett prints)

Greens

Reds/Pinks

Blues

Yellows/Yellow Oranges

And Single Quarter of White

Your choice for Sashing (Non-Background part):

1 1/4 Yard

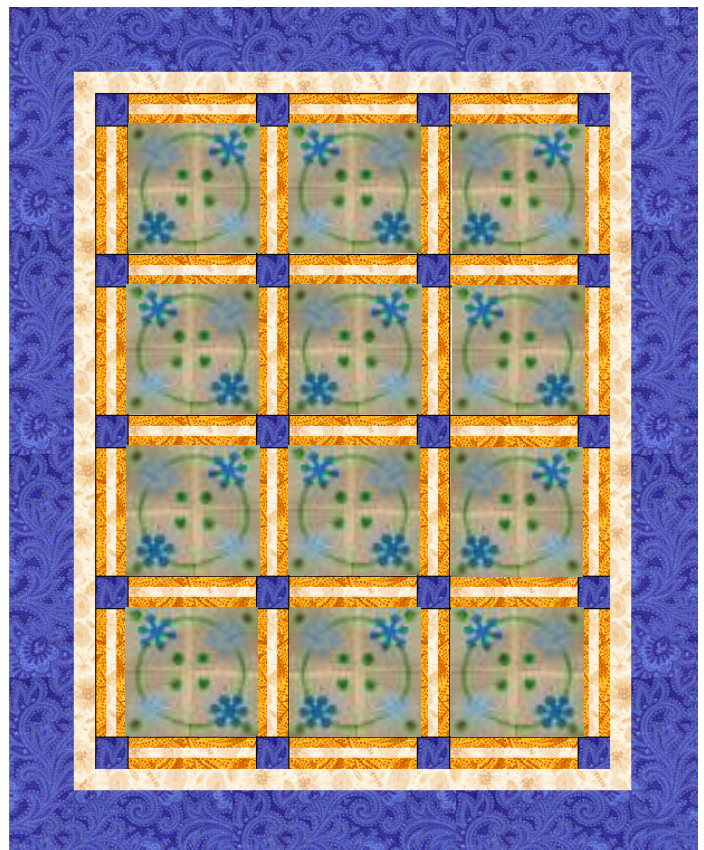
Border/Binding/Cornerstones:

2 1/2 Yards

(You can wait on the Border fabric
until your blocks are complete)

Also:

1 1/2 yards of Paper Backed Fusible Web
(I like HeatNBond Lite)



Here is a mock up of the Quilt layout with a draft of the January Block (Snowflowers) used throughout. The actual blocks will each have different flowers in different colors and different shaped wreaths.

The overall finished effect will be a Baltimore Album type quilt.
