10 ea. 1" X 15" Strips


4 ea. 21/2" X Width of Fabric Strips (Binding)


Prep for appliqué your favorite way: (Still Red)

3 Heart templates (Given)


Assembly:


- 1. Cut each 9" Square along one diagonal. Insert 1 or 1 1/2" strip of opposite color. Make 5 Red and 5 White.
- 2. Now cut on the opposite diagonal and insert another strip as shown. Make five of each. Trim all squares to 9", keeping the center true.
- 3. Cut each square along the center and the middle to make 4 Blocks. In total, you should have 20 mostly White Blocks and 20 mostly Red Blocks.
- 4. Arrange the squares following diagram at below, stitching 10 rows of 4 squares.
- 5. Applique the hearts to the center of Runner as shown on diagram.
- 6. Layer, quilt and bind as desired.
- 7. Happy Valentine's Day!
