

create wallhanging (9" X 12")

Supplies:

- 12 ea. 3 1/2" squares in teals, light to dark, some repeats okay
 - 1 ea. 2 1/2" X 40" teal print for binding
 - 1 ea. 8" X 10" red (mine was a painted piece that gradated light to dark)
Use more than one red to get this effect if necessary as desired)
 - 1 ea. 2 1/2" X 12" red for binding
 - 1 ea. 8" X 10" Paper Backed Fusible Web (I like Heat N Bond Light)
- Backing and Backing for this size quilt

Preparation: Trace *create* (provided) to PBFW. Fuse to Red. Mine was fused so the light was at the start of the word. Cut out.

Assembly:

1. Lay out your teal squares following the picture into a pleasing layout of 4 squares by 3 squares. Stitch together.
2. Remove the paper from red *create*. Position as desired and fuse in place. Stitch using a narrow, tight zigzag (about a 1 length and a two width) and matching thread. I used a medium red throughout.
3. Layer with backing and batting.
4. Quilt as desired. I did a lot of quilting which was fun on this small piece. First I outlined a simple exclamation mark and a few periods and the *create*. Then I did tight vertical lines to fill in. I also did a section of horizontal lines in the dark area. Just have fun!
5. Bind with 2 1/2" strips.
