# NAU'TICAL 'TUMBLE SAMPLER QUIL'T' <br> BLOCK THREE AND FOUR-RECTANGLES

One Set of Instructions... Two Different Blocks...With Just A Single Turn!

## CU'ITIING:

From Mediums: 24ea. 3 1/2" X 2 1/2" Rectangles
From Darks: 24 ea. $31 / 2 "$ X $21 / 2$ " Rectangles
REMEMBER, YOU ARE MAKING TWO BLOCKS.

## ASSEMBLY:

1. Separate rectangles in two groups of 24 each with 12 Mediums and 12 Darks. The groups do not have to have the exact same fabrics. Mix them up a bit.
2. Layout each group into four rows of six rectangles, alternating Mediums and Darks.
3. Stitch those rows together.


Vertical Block
4. Stitch rows into blocks. With just a single, simple turn, you have two different blocks!
5. Blocks should measure $121 / 2$ ". If desired, they will be trimmed to Tumbler Shape* later.
