One Set of Instructions... Two Different Blocks... With Just A Single Turn!

CUTTING:

From Mediums: 24ea. 3 1/2" X 2 1/2" Rectangles From Darks: 24 ea. 3 1/2" X 2 1/2" Rectangles REMEMBER, YOU ARE MAKING TWO BLOCKS.

ASSEMBLY:

- 1. Separate rectangles in two groups of 24 each with 12 Mediums and 12 Darks. The groups do not have to have the exact same fabrics. Mix them up a bit.
- 2. Layout each group into four rows of six rectangles, alternating Mediums and Darks.
- 3. Stitch those rows together.
- 4. Stitch rows into blocks. With just a single, simple turn, you have two different blocks!
- 5. Blocks should measure 12 1/2". If desired, they will be trimmed to Tumbler Shape* later.
