Background:	1/2 Yard
Backing:	5/8 Yard
Leaf:	3/8 Yard
Yellow 1:	1/8 Yard
Yellow 2:	1/8 Yard
Gold:	1/8 Yard

Cutting:

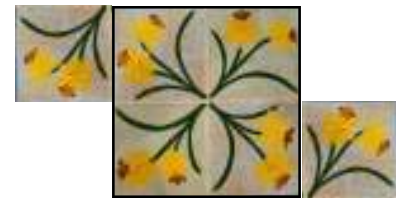
1 ea. 12 1/2” Background Square

6 ea. 6 1/2” Background Square

Prep for Applique: One Full Block and 6 Quarter Daffodil Blocks.

Assembly:

1. Using Pattern given, Applique one Full Block and 6 Quarter Daffodil Blocks.
2. Here’s where this gets a bit weird... Stitch one Quarter Square to one edge of the Full Block as shown. In a similar manner, stitch another Quarter Block to the opposite corner as shown. Start stitching at the corner for proper alignment. Be sure the flowers are oriented as shown.
3. Now stitch the remaining four blocks into two pairs, both oriented as shown at right.
4. Add these pairs as shown to complete the tablerunner top.
5. Layout the batting. Place the Quilt Top Right Sides Together with Backing and place atop batting with Quilt Top on top. Trim away excess backing and batting beyond the quilt top.
6. Stitch all around, leaving an opening to turn. Clip/trim corners before turning right side out.
7. Press crisply. Quilt as desired and top stitch close to edge.
8. Enjoy the beauty of spring anytime you use this runner!





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Applique Pattern (One Quarter Given)

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Make one full by tracing four blocks (rotated). Also make 6 single Blocks.
