

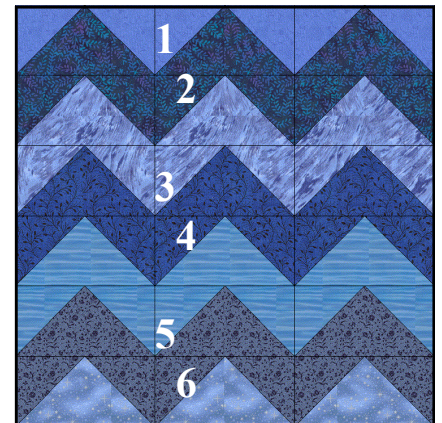
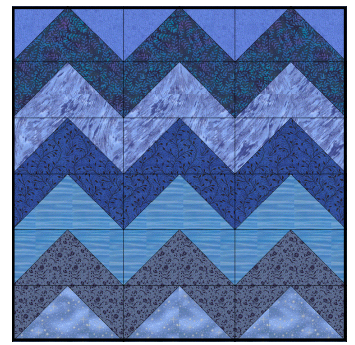
NAUTICAL TUMBLE QUILT: BLOCK TWELVE—THE SWELLS

Cutting:

Six Fabrics: Three Darks And Three Mediums:
Cut 3 ea. 4 1/2" x 2 1/2" rectangles (Geese) and
6 ea. 2 1/2" squares (Sky) of each fabric

Assembly Summary:

Lay out the fabrics alternating medium and dark, number them from One to Six. Follow the instructions below to make three Flying Geese blocks with Fabric 1 as Sky and Fabric 2 as Geese, three with Fabric 2 as Sky and Fabric 3 as Geese, three with Fabric 3 as Sky and Fabric 4 as Geese and so on as shown. (Note: Your last set should have Fabric 6 as Sky and Fabric 1 as Geese.)

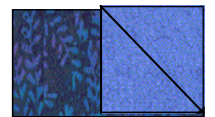


Mark or Press all Squares with one diagonal.

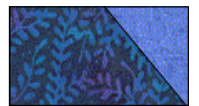
Flying Geese:

1. Place a square (Sky) on one edge of a corresponding rectangle (Geese) right sides together with the marked diagonal oriented as shown. Stitch along diagonal and trim excess to 1/4". Press.

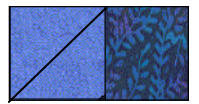
2. Place a second square (Sky) opposite edge of the rectangle as shown. Once again, stitch along diagonal. Trim and press. Make 18 Flying Geese blocks 2 1/2" X 4 1/2".

Trim and Fold Back



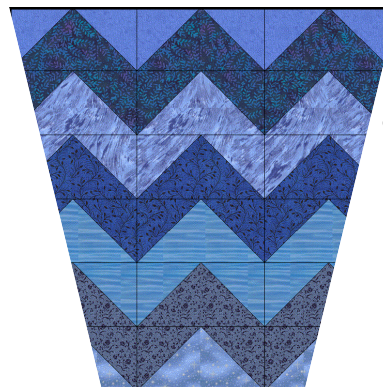
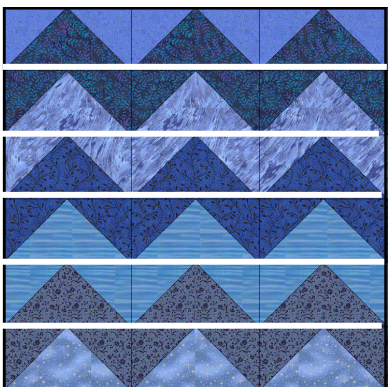
Stitch Second Sky

Block Assembly:

To make the Swells block, make 6 rows of three blocks the same. Be sure to lay out the blocks in the progressive manner discussed above as shown.



We will trim all the blocks to the Tumbler shape when they are all complete. Stay tuned!
