

NAUTICAL TUMBLE QUILT: BLOCK FOURTEEN—SAILS



Cutting:

Cut 36 triangles from template given or use an Equilateral Triangle (60 Degree) Ruler and 3 3/4" Strips. Cut triangles from a variety of Medium (18 Triangles) and Dark (18 Triangles) fabrics.


NOTE: This alternating value layout is just one possibility. See what other designs you can make if desired.

Assembly Summary:

Lay out the triangles alternating medium and dark.

Block Assembly:

To make the Sails block, lay out the cut triangles into four rows of 9 triangles as shown in the block below. Stitch the rows together. Trim away excess to 12 1/2" square.



Note: Don't let the triangles worry you. They are completely symmetrical. Just line up the points when you sew and keep to your quarter inch seams.



We will trim all the blocks to the Tumbler shape when they are all complete. Stay tuned!

Please be sure this printed template measures 3 3/4" tip to base before starting. If needed, extend side lines and add a new base line.
