

NAUTICAL TUMBLE

BLOCK 10-PINWHEELS

Accuracy counts with these small pinwheels.

Need: 16 ea. 5" squares:

8 Medium (2 ea. of 4 different), 8 Dark (2 ea. of 4 different)

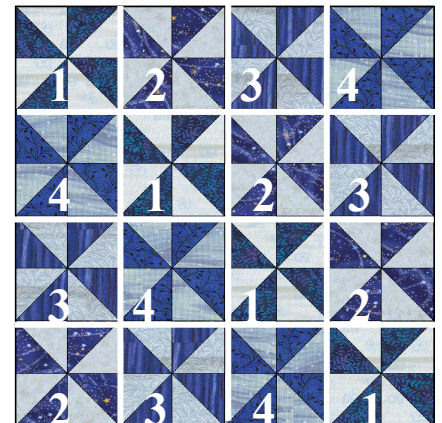
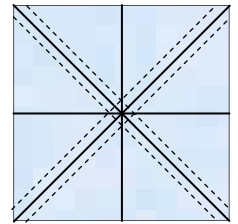
Assembly:

1. Draw or press in both diagonals and the cross lines on the medium squares. Pair up each pair of medium squares with a pair of dark squares.

2. Layer one medium right sides together with its chosen dark. Stitch $\frac{1}{4}$ " on both sides of the diagonal lines. Cut on the diagonal and the cross lines creating eight half square triangles (HSTs). Repeat, matching medium with its dark, to make 64 HSTs. HSTs should measure at least 2" or slightly larger. We will trim after making Pinwheels as necessary.

3. Lay out 8 matching HSTs to form a Pinwheel as shown. Stitch as shown. Trim Pinwheel to $3\frac{1}{2}$ " keeping center at $1\frac{3}{4}$ ". Make four Pinwheels the same. Repeat to make four sets of four Pinwheels.

4. Lay your out block following the diagram at right, where 1 represents your darkest set of pinwheels and so on... OR in any other pleasing arrangement. Stitch to finish block. Block should measure $12\frac{1}{2}$ ".



We will trim all the blocks to the Tumbler shape when they are all complete. Stay tuned!
