

NAUTICAL TUMBLE QUILT: BLOCK SIXTEEN: OLD BARNEY

Here is a folk art representation of Barnegat Bay Light, with it's distinctive red over white color scheme. Make this Old Barney block or use this as a jumping off point to make your own favorite (or Fantasy!) lighthouse for your Nautical Tumble Quilt.

Two Different Lights:

2 each 7" squares of each
(4 squares total)

Light for tip and bottom, dark (pink) for top, Plaids for light and rail sections, gray for roof, greens for base. Prep for Applique Your Favorite Way

Assembly:

1. Stitch the four 7" light squares into a 4-Patch with fabric alternating for the background square.
2. Arrange lighthouse atop Applique Pressing Sheet, Release Paper or Parchment Paper.
2. Applique lighthouse centered on the background aligning along seamlines.
3. Trim square to 12 1/2" OR reserve to be trimmed to Tumbler Shape* later.
