

NAUTICAL TUMBLE QUILT: BLOCK SEVENTEEN

HATCHES OF PATCHES

Use as few as three Fabrics or as many as you like...

Cutting:

Light:

9 ea, A 1 1/2" squares

Medium

10 ea. B 1 1/2" X 1 1/4"

10 ea. C 3" X 1 1/4"

8 ea. D 3" X 1 1/4"

8 ea. E 4 1/2" X 1 1/4"

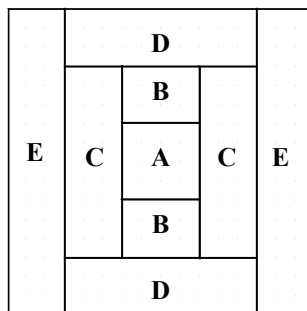
Dark:

8 ea. B 1 1/2" X 1 1/4"

8 ea. C 3" X 1 1/4"

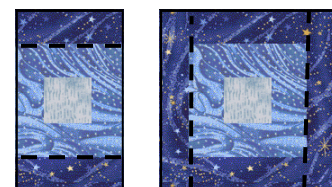
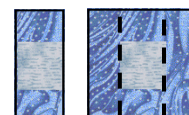
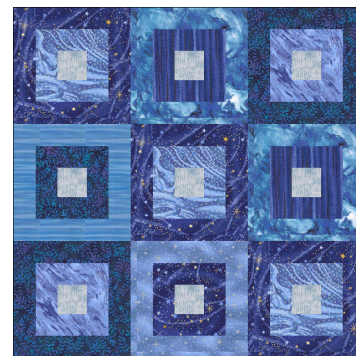
10 ea. D 3" X 1 1/4"

10 ea. E 4 1/2" X 1 1/4"

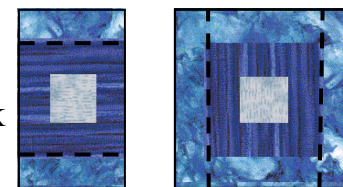
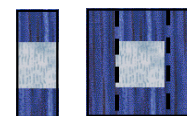


Assembly:

1. Make 5 "Dark" Hatches: Stitch Medium Bs to opposite sides (Top and Bottom) of one Light A. Add Medium Cs to remaining sides. Make 5.
2. Next add Dark Ds to Top and Bottom of blocks. Finish with Dark E along sides. Make 5 "Dark" Hatches measuring 4 1/2".
3. Make 4 "Medium" Hatches. Stitch Dark Bs to opposite sides (Top and Bottom) of one Light A. Add Dark Cs to remaining sides. Make 4.
4. Next add Medium Ds to Top and Bottom of blocks. Finish with Medium E along sides. Make 4 "Medium" Hatches measuring 4 1/2".
5. Make Hatches of Patches Block: Make two rows that are Dark-Medium-Dark Hatches (That's Row A) and one Row that is Medium-Dark-Medium Hatches (That's Row B). (Note: It is much easier to stitch together the small bullseyes if every other one is turned 90 degrees... So the seams never have to match up! SO... Turn all the Mediums 90 degrees)
6. Stitch the rows together in Row A-B-A fashion as shown in the diagram at right to complete the block. Block should measure 12 1/2" square.

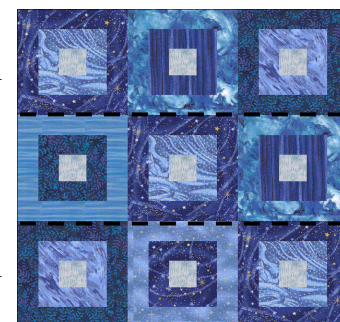


Make 5 "Medium" Hatches
