## Two Different Lights:

2 each 7" squares of each (4 squares total)
Prep for Applique Your Favorite Way: Light for sail, Medium for Hull, Darks for cabin, boom and mast:

## Assembly:

1. Stitch the four 7 " light squares into a 4-Patch with fabric alternating for the background square.
2. Arrange CatBoat atop Applique Pressing Sheet or Parchment Paper.
3. Applique boat, centered on the background aligning along seamlines.
4. Trim square to $121 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ OR reserve to be trimmed to Tumbler Shape* later.

Dark Lines indicate Applique. Thinner lines are rigging to be inked or embroidered. Check block image above for appliqué. Image block has not yet been inked.
