## NAU'IICAL 'TUMBLE ASSEMBLY

Start With Trimmed Blocks (either 12 1/2" or Tumbler/Thimble Shape) Cutting:
From Dark:
Cut 10 half blocks-dark (Cut 5 blocks from dark then cut in half vertically) (Skip if not doing Tumbler shape) AND 3 (7 if not Tumbling!) ea. 3" WoF strips (Top and Bottom Borders)
AND 8 ea. 2 1/2" strips for binding From Light: (Two yard piece on Supply List)
Cut four length of Fabric Strips each 7 1/2" wide OR
8 ea. Width of Fabric Strips each $71 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ wide.

## Assembly:

1. Lay out Five rows of five blocks...Three rows starting with an Applique block. Two rows starting with a Pieced block. Get a nice arrangement that is balanced and dynamic. Make rows.
2. Add the dark half Tumbler blocks to both ends of each row to "square up." Stitch the rows together. (Add 3" border to sides if not doing Tumbler shape.)
3. Add 3 " border to top and bottom.
4. Complete with 7" light border.
5. Layer with backing and batting. Quilt as desired.

6 . Bind with $21 / 2$ " dark strips.


Representative of the quilt without cutting to Tumbler Shape. Again... Not all blocks are correct.


Complete by adding borders, layering, Quilting and Binding.


Stitch Rows together. Then add Dark half blocks to complete rows. Note: Not all blocks are represented in this mock up, just enough to get the idea across...


Add Half Blocks, Stitch rows together then add top and bottom borders.
