

Honey Bee Block

From A 10" Fabric Square Swap (40 Squares Total) Block: 10" Finished, 10 1/2" Unfinished

Cutting For Each Block:

From 10" Swap Squares

5 ea. 2 1/2" Squares

Prep for Applique Your Favorite Way...

4 ea. Leaf Clusters (Template Below)

Background:

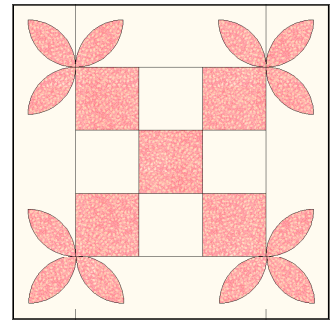
4 ea. 2 1/2" Squares

2 ea. 2 1/2" X 6 1/2" Rectangles

2 ea. 2 1/2" X 10 1/2" Rectangles

Assembly:

1. Stitch a pink and a white square together. Press to the pink. Make 3.
2. Add pink square to the white edge of a Step 1 unit. Press to the pink. Make 2.
3. Add a white square to the pink edge of a step 1 unit. Press to the pink.
4. Stitch a Step 2 unit to the top of a Step 3 unit aligning seamlines. In a similar fashion, add a Step 2 unit to the bottom of this unit, again aligning seamlines to create a 9-Patch Block as Shown
5. Add a 2 1/2" X 6 1/2" White Rectangle to the top of the 9-Patch. Also add a 2 1/2" X 6 1/2" White Rectangle to the Bottom of the 9-Patch. Press to the 9-Patch.
6. Now add a 2 1/2" X 10 1/2" White Rectangle to the Right hand Side of the Block. Also add a 2 1/2" X 10 1/2" White Rectangle to the Left hand Side of the Block. Press to the 9-Patch. Square to 10 1/2".
7. Fold the block in half diagonally and gently crease a guide. Repeat for the other diagonal.
8. Applique the leaf clusters at each corner of the 9-Patch using the creased guide for placement to complete your Honey Bee Block.
9. Sash (Need 57 ea. 2" X 10 1/2" Cut) your blocks using the "Ls of Sashing Method." (Need 35 ea. 2" Cut Cornerstones)
10. Layer with Backing and Batting.
11. Quilt as desired.
12. Bind with 2 1/2" Pink Strips.

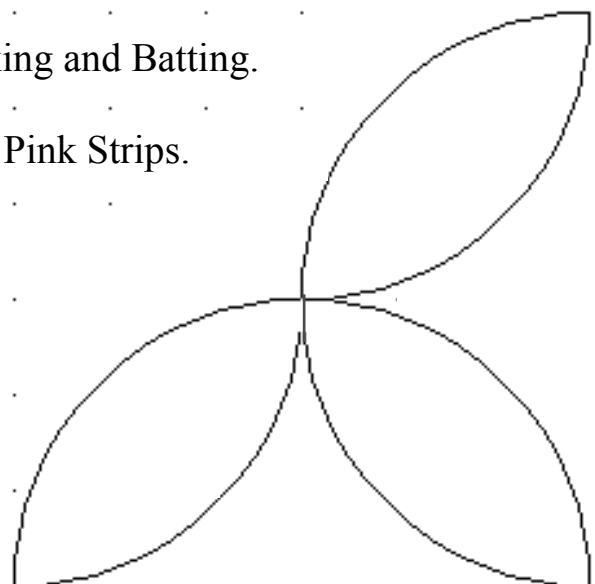
1 1/2 Yard (Pink?) for Sashing and Binding
