## Ruffled Scarf

## **Supplies:**

2 yards T-Shirt Knit (enough for 3-4 scarves!) and Matching Thread

1 1/2 yards 1/4" Elastic

## **Cutting:**

13" x 72" Rectangle of T-Shirt Knit

## **Assembly:**

- 1. Fold knit rectangle in half lengthwise. Stitch with RST 1/4" seam along long edge only to form a tube. Do NOT stitch short edges. Turn Right Side Out.
- 2. Press with seam along one long edge and a crease along opposite edge.
- 3. Place a pin(x) 1 1/2" in and 1 1/2" over from seam edge on each short end. Also place a pin(x) in the middle of the length 1 1/2" in from seam edge as shown.
- 4. Starting at pin 1 stitch to pin 2 and on the pin 3 in a straight a line as possible.
- 5. Form a casing by stitching about 3/8" away from first line of stitching, leaving ends of casing open.
- 6. Insert elastic into casing using a safety pin or bodkin. Pin as end of elastic comes even with end of stitching. Allow knit tube to gather on elastic. Gather to your liking for fullness and length. Secure other end of elastic at other end of casing with a straight pin. Stitch and backtack over both ends of elastic to secure.
- 7. Turn in short ends of scarf tube. Pin and press then top stitch the short edges to finish your scarf.
