

EAR BUD/PHONE CORD CASE

Supplies:

6 coordinating 4" to 5" squares

Assembly:

1. Place two squares wrong sides together.
2. Fold all remaining squares in half, wrong sides together.
3. Matching raw edges, place one folded square (A) atop the Step 1 squares. Pin. Working around the edge and pin, place the next folded square (B) and pin, then the next (C) and pin, then the last folded square (D) gets tucked under the first folded square) and pinned.
4. Baste all around the edge. Using the Circle Template (4") given, center template on the basted squares. Trace around (I used a Sharpie). Stitch on the line and trim seam allowance to a Scant quarter inch. Finish raw edges with a zig-zag if desired.
5. Turn thru the folded squares. Press.
6. Insert mobile phone cords/ear phones thru the folded squares to store.
