

## **Supplies:**


6 coordinating 4" to 5" squares

## **Assembly:**


- 1. Place two squares wrong sides together.
- 2. Fold all remaining squares in half, wrong sides together.
- 3. Matching raw edges, place one folded square (A) atop the Step 1 squares. Pin. Working around the edge and pin, place the next folded square (B) and pin, then the next © and pin, then the last folded square (D) gets tucked under the first folded square) and pinned.
- 4. Baste all around the edge. Using the Circle Template (4") given, center template on the basted squares. Trace around (I used a Sharpie). Stitch on the line and trim seam allowance to a Scant quarter inch. Finish raw edges with a zigzag if desired.





6. Insert mobile phone cords/ear phones thru the folded squares to store.
