

# Tea Towel Hat (Reversible) From LynBrown.com

## Supplies:

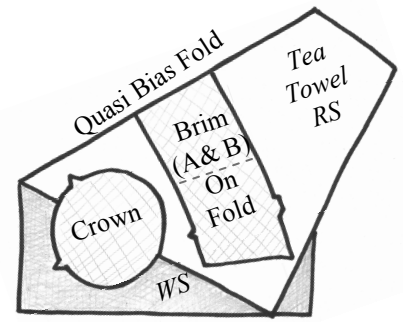
Two new Tea Towels approximately 20" x 28", washed and pressed with starch.

Cut one of each pattern piece from each Tea Towel.

Note that Brim should be cut on a "Kind of" (not necessarily exactly) bias fold. Check suggested layout at right.

## Assembly:

1. Stitch the Brim seam on each Brim, matching notches.
2. Pin each Brim to its matching Crown, matching notches. Stitch. Press.
3. Turn one Hat inside out. Place other Hat inside so right sides are together. Match notches along outer edge of brim and stitch, leaving an opening for turning.
4. Turn Hat right side out. Press. Top stitch along outer edge of Brim catching opening. That's IT!



Fold Tea Towel "Kind of" Bias.  
Cut Brim on fold,  
then cut Crown of single layer

Attach Brim A to Brim B at Dashed Line Before Cutting from Fabric

## Tea Towel Hat

**BRIM Part A** (Join to Part B Matching Dashed Lines)  
Cut one on Bias Fold

# Tea Towel Hat

## Crown (Circle)

Cut one and one of Lining

Attach Brim B to Brim A at Dashed Line Before Cutting from Fabric

# Tea Towel Hat

## BRIM Part B

(Join to Part A  
Matching Dashed Lines)  
Cut one on Fold  
and one of Lining on Bias Fold



Place on BIAS FOLD
