

# Grandma's Victory Quilt 

From www.LynBrown.com 63 ea. 8" Blocks set 7x9 $66^{\prime \prime}$ x $82^{\prime \prime}$ or $75^{\prime \prime} \times 91^{\prime \prime}$ with pieced border

## Supplies:

Background (White): $21 / 2$ yards
Solid Accent (Pink): 2 1/2 yards
Colorful Prints: Swap of 10" Squares (40) OR
Fat Quarters (15-20 for variety) OR A Great Scrap Bag!
Cutting:
Background: 16 ea. 2 1/2" Width of Fabric Strips. (Set 8 strips aside for Inner Border) 8 ea. 4 1/2" Width of Fabric Strips
SubCut these into 126 ea. 2 1/2" X 4 1/2" Rectangles
Solid Accent: 16 ea. 2 1/2" Width of Fabric Strips (Set 8 of these aside for binding)


Note: Original Quilt had TWO Y-Seams in every Block! Block has been redrafted to eliminate these.

8 ea. 3 1/2" x Width of Fabric Border Strips
Colorful Prints: Cut 63 pairs of $41 / 2$ squares for Blocks
If Pieced Border Is Desired, also cut 148 ea. 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" Rectangles and 4 ea. $41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares (could do these 4 from the Solid Accent above)

## Assembly Instructions:

1. Make Strip Sets of the Background and Solid Accent by stitching a Background 2 $1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip to a Solid Accent $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip along the long edge. Press to dark. Repeat to make 8 Background/Solid Accent strip sets.
2. Cut step 1 Strip Sets into 126 ea. 2 1/2" x $41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ units as shown.
3. Watching orientation, add a background $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ X $41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Rectangle to the left side

Step 5 of all of the step 2 units.
4. Stitch a Colorful Print $41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square to the right side of the step 3 unit. Make 126.
5. Stitch 2 step 4 units together (with the Same Colorful square) as shown (watch orientation) to complete a Grandma's Victory block. Block should measure $81 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square. Make 63 blocks.
6. Make a row of 7 blocks being sure to give every other block a quarter turn. Make 9 rows of seven blocks. Stitch together the quilt center.
7. Add Inner Border of $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Background Strips.
8. Add Solid Accent Border of $31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips.
9. If pieced border is desired, stitch together a strip of 33 Colorful rectangles. Make 2. Add to top and bottom of quilt. Make two more strips of 41 Colorful Rectangles. Add the 4 1/2" squares to ends. Add these to sides of quilt to complete.
10. Layer with batting and backing. Quilt as desired.
11. Bind with $21 / 2^{"}$ strips of Solid Accent.
