

BoHo Bricks Quilt



BoHo Bricks Block Assembly:


- 1.Stitch a Background C (Gray) Rectangle to each Short end of each all Light Blue A Rectangles. Make 16.
- 2. Stitch A Middle Border (Black) D Square to one end only of each Medium Blue A Rectangle. Make 16.
- 3. Stitch a Light Blue Step 1 unit to a Medium Blue Step 2 unit. Repeating with the <u>same fabrics</u>, make 4 and 4 Reversed as shown. Reversed units have St. 2 unit flipped.
- 4. Using <u>remaining Blue units</u>, stitch a Light Blue Step 1 unit to a Medium Blue Step 2 unit. Make 4 and 4 Reversed as shown. Reversed units have St. 2 unit flipped.
- 5. Stitch together a Step 3 unit and a Step 4 unit to make the Blue BoHo Bricks block. Make 4 (Bl) and 4 Reversed (BlR) Blue BoHo Bricks blocks as shown.
- 6. Stitch a Background C (Gray) Rectangle to each Short end of each all Light Green A Rectangles. Make 16.
- 7. Stitch A Middle Border (Black) D Square to one end only of each Medium Green A Rectangle. Make 16.
- 8. Stitch a Lt. Green Step 1 unit to a Medium Green Step 2 unit. Repeating with the <u>same fabrics</u>, make 4 and 4 Reversed as shown. Reversed units have St. 2 unit flipped.
- 9. Using <u>remaining Green units</u>, stitch a Light Green Step 1 unit to a Medium Green Step 2 unit. Make 4 and 4 Reversed as shown. Reversed units have St. 2 unit flipped.
- 10. Stitch together a Step 8 unit and a Step 9 unit to make the Green BoHo Bricks block. Make 4 (Gr) and 4 Reversed (GrR) Green BoHo Bricks blocks as shown.
