



# Mid Century Modern Sampler

## Block 2 - Chevrons

### Cutting:

#### Background:

3 ea. 3" x 5 1/2" rectangles

6 ea. 3" squares

1 ea. 8" x 15 1/2"(Top)

1 ea. 3 1/2" x 15 1/2" (Bottom)

#### Color 1:

3 ea. 3" x 5 1/2" rectangles

6 ea. 3" squares






#### Color 2:

3 ea. 3" x 5 1/2" rectangles

6 ea. 3" squares

### Assembly:

1. Snowball a Background Square onto a Color 1 rectangle. (Snowball by creasing or marking one diagonal on the square, placing RST together to rectangle as shown and stitching.) Trim excess. Fold back. Repeat for other side to make a Flying Geese Block. Trim. (Note that you will have seam allowance at top. Block shown is how it will be in quilt.) Make three Flying Geese with Background Sky and Color 1 Geese 3" x 5 1/2".
2. In a similar manner, make three Flying Geese with Color 1 Sky and Color 2 Geese
3. Make three more Geese, now with Color 2 Sky and Background Geese.
4. Stitch a Step 1 unit to a Step 2 unit as shown. Add a Step 3 unit at the bottom. Make 3. Press two with seams down and one with seams up.
5. Stitch the three Step 4 units together (have the one with seams pressed up in the middle) as shown.
6. Add top and bottom Background Rectangles to complete block. Should measure 18 1/2" x 15 1/2".




