

# Mid Century Modern Sampler

## Block 3 - Cypress Bricks

9" x 12" Finished

### Cutting:

#### Background:

4 ea. 12 1/2" x 3/4" D rectangles\*

6 ea. 2 1/2" X 3/4" B rectangles\*

#### Light:

1 ea. 6 1/4" x 2 1/2" A rectangle

1 ea. 3 1/2" X 2 1/2" E rectangle

1 ea. 3" X 2 1/2" F rectangle

#### Dark:

1 ea. 6 1/2" x 2 1/2" C rectangle

1 ea. 3" X 2 1/2" F rectangle

#### Color 1:

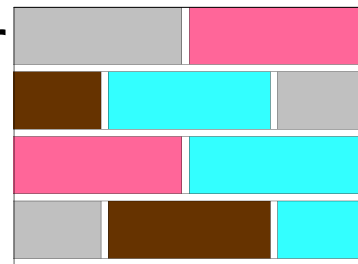
2 ea. 6 1/2" x 2 1/2" C rectangles

1 ea. 3 1/2" X 2 1/2" E rectangle

#### Color 2:

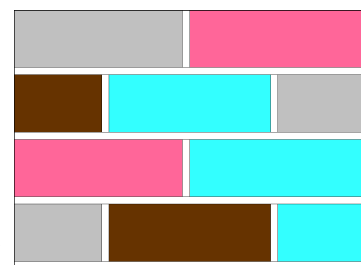
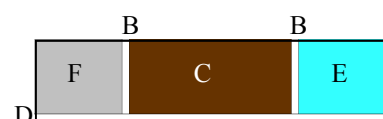
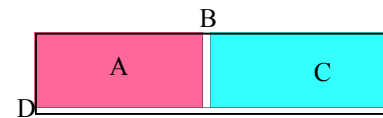
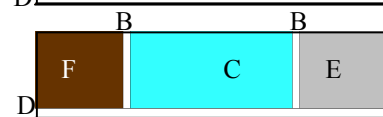
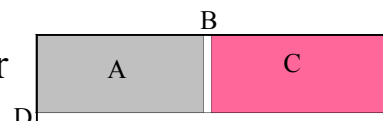
1 ea. 6 1/4" x 2 1/2" A rectangle

1 ea. 6 1/2" x 2 1/2" C rectangle



### Assembly: (Follow block diagram above)

1. Stitch a Background B rectangle between a Light A and a Color 2 C Rectangle. Add a Background D across bottom.
2. Stitch a Background B between a Dark F and a Color 1 C rectangle. Add another B to opposite side of the Color 1 C, then add a Light E Rectangle. Add a Background D across bottom.
3. Stitch a Background B rectangle between a Color 2 A and a Color 1 C Rectangle. Add a Background D across bottom.
4. Stitch a Background B between a Light F and a Dark C rectangle. Add another B to opposite side of the Dark C, then add a Color 1 E Rectangle. Add a Background D across bottom.
5. Stitch the units from Step 1– 4, in step order, to complete block. Block should measure 9 1/2" X 12 1/2".



**\*THE Trick to sewing a 3/4" patch to finish at 1/4":**

*Stitch the first seam as usual.*

*When stitching the second seam on patch to finish at 1/4", run your quarter inch foot along the first seam instead of along the edge of the fabric.*

*Don't worry if the seam allowance is 1/4", but work to ensure the PATCH is 1/4"!*
