



Swan Christmas Tree Ornament

Supplies:

2 ea. 6" X 7 1/2" Rectangles of Burlap

Fabric Scraps: White 6" square, Water Blue: 2" X 6", Red: 1" square

8" square of Paper Backed Fusible Web

Stuffing

12" of 1/2" White Twill Tape

Stuffing

Prep For Applique: Swan (Four Templates Below)

Assembly:

1. Applique Swan, centered on one burlap rectangle.
2. Layer the two burlap rectangles, wrong sides together. Stitch 1" from edge, leaving an opening to stuff.
3. Stuff Ornament with stuffing. Stitch opening closed.
4. Stitch a second line of stitching 1/4" outside first line, tucking in and catching the short ends of the twill tape along top of ornaments to make a hanging ribbon.
5. Pull away burlap threads parallel to the stitching on burlap to form a fringe.
