## Mid Century Modern Sampler—Color Block Borders

Cutting: From Background for Borders
32 ea. 1 1/2" X 6 1/2" 4 ea. 1 1/2" X 5 1/2" Color 1:
4 ea. 6 1/2" X 9 1/2" 4 ea. 6 1/2" X 10 1/2" 3 ea. 5 1/2" X 5 1/2" Color 2:
8 ea. 6 1/2" X 9 1/2" 1 ea. $51 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 51 / 2$ " Light:
4 ea. 6 1/2" X 9 1/2"
4 ea. 6 1/2" X 10 1/2"
Dark:
8 ea. 6 1/2" X 9 1/2"
Add $51 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ X $11 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Background to top of $51 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square. Add $61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ X $11 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Background to side.
Make 3 with Color 1 squares and 1 with Color 2 square.





Following diagrams at left, assemble 4 Part A sections and 4 Part B Sections. Also make the Corners (Part C) as shown. Add corners to Top and Bottom Parts as appropriate following diagram above. Add Border Parts to MCM Mega Blocks as shown, watching orientation.
Assemble the quilt, putting the 4 Mega Blocks together as shown at right. Layer Quilt with Backing and Batting and quilt as desired. Bind with 2 1/2" strips of Background.
