## The Christmas Sweater Quilt (60" X 70") Pg. 1/2

From A Swap of 40 ea. 10" Squares of Christmas Fabrics

**Other Supplies:** 2 1/2 yards ea of two different Backgrounds (1-2)... Sample had off white lightly designed with color (green and gold) (Think shirtings or...?) & 3/4 yard print for Binding (8-2 1/2" Strips).

Mittens

Prep for appliqué your favorite way, using swap squares or scraps:

10 V Neck Sweaters

10 Crew Neck Sweaters

10 Vests

16 Hats

4 pairs of mittens

## **Cutting:**

Cut 10 ea. 13" squares of Background 1 for Sweaters

Cut 10 ea. 13" squares of Background 2 for Sweaters

Cut 5 ea. 13" X 7" of Background 1 for Vests

Cut 5 ea. 13" X 7" of Background 2 for Vests

Cut 4 ea. 13" x 6" of Background 1 for Hats

Cut 4 ea 13" X 6" of Background 2 for Hats

Cut 4 ea. 6" X 7" of asst'd Backgrounds for Mittens

## Assembly:

- 1. Backgrounds should alternate. Lay out as necessary to decide which appliqué goes on which background. Applique Sweaters, Vests and Hats (2 on each) onto the Backgrounds centered. Add a wide tight zigzag at the sackgrounds centered.
  - the Backgrounds centered. Add a wide, tight zigzag at the Neck, Cuffs and Hem to mimic ribbing. Trim Sweater blocks to 12 1/2", Vests to 12 1/2" X 6 1/2", Hats to 5 1/2" X 12 1/2" and Mittens to 5 1/2" X 6 1/2" after appliqué is complete.
- 2. Following diagram below, assemble the quilt center, row by row. The Vests, Hats and Mitten blocks become the border.
- 3. Layer with Backing and Batting. Quilt as desired. Bind with 2 1/2" Strips.



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
