


Game On! Mystery

Clue Two



Cutting:

Color ONE Dark: 48 ea. 3 1/2" Squares Background: 12 ea. 6 1/2" Squares Color THREE Bright: 2 ea. 2 1/2" X Width of Fabric (WoF) Strip Color TWO Dark: 2 ea. 2 1/2" X Width of Fabric (WoF) Strip


Assembly:


Part A

- Snowball, using a Diagonal Seam as shown, a Color ONE Dark Onto two opposite corners of a Background Square. Make 12. Trim away excess. Press out.
- 2. Snowball a Color ONE Dark onto the remaining corners of the Background squares to make 12 Square In A Square units. Trim away excess. Press out. Unit should measure 6 1/2". Make 12.

Part B

- 1. Stitch together a Color TWO Dark Strip with a Color THREE Bright Strip as shown. Make 2 Strip Sets.
- 2. Cut Step 1 Strip Sets into 2 1/2" units. Cut 26 Units.
- 3. Using the Step 2 units, make 4-Patches as shown. Make 13 ea. 4-Patches. 4-Patches should measure 4 1/2".
