For this week's 9-Patch A (Center) cut:
4 ea. $11 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ WoF strips Background.
3 ea. $11 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ WoF strips Red
2 ea. $11 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ WoF strips Blue

## Making The "A" 9-Patches:

1. To make the 9 -Patches for this quilt, cut width of fabric (Selvedge to selvedge) $11 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips for each patch in the block.
2. Stitch strips together into 3-strip Strip Sets representing each row of the block ( 3 total). Press top and bottom row Strip Sets to the outside and middle row Strip Set to the
 center.

## So for the 9-Patch A Units:

Strip Set 1 is Red-Background-Blue
Strip Set 2 is Background-Red-Background
Strip Set 3 is Blue-Background-Red (Same as Strips Set 1, but flipped around)
3. Cut the $41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ wide strip sets into $11 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ units ( 25 from each).
4. Assemble the units, watching their orientation into the 9-Patch A Units. Make 25.
