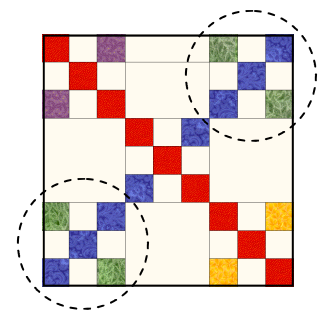


Nostalgic Nine In Nine Quilt 2014 Week 4

(75" X 75")



So for this week's 9-Patch D (Lower Left/Upper Right), cut:

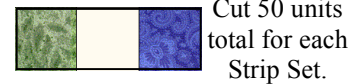
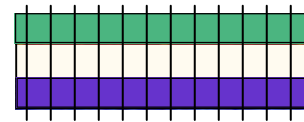
8 ea. 1 1/2" WoF strips Background.

6 ea. 1 1/2" WoF strips Blue

4 ea. 1 1/2" WoF strips Green

Making The "D" 9-Patches:

1. To make the 9-Patches for this quilt, cut width of fabric (Selvedge to Selvedge) 1 1/2" strips for each patch in the block.
2. Stitch strips together into 3-strip strip sets representing each row of the block. You'll need 2 strips sets for each row (6 total). Press top and bottom rows to the outside and middle row to the center. Strip Sets should measure 3 1/2".



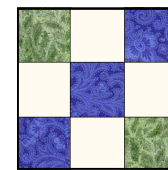
So for the 9-Patch D Units:

Strip Set 1 is Green-Background-Blue (Make 2)

Strip Set 2 is Background-Blue-Background (Make 2)

Strip Set 3 is Blue-Background-Green (Make 2)

3. Cut the 3 1/2" wide strip sets into 1 1/2" units (50 from each set).
4. Assemble the units, watching their orientation into the 9-Patch D Units. Block should measure 3 1/2" raw. Make 50.
