Making the 9 In 9

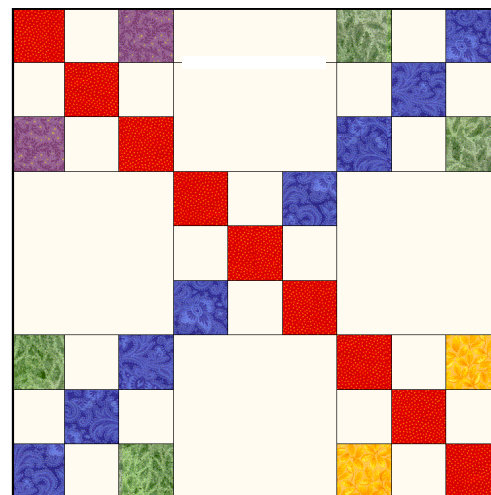
Cutting:

From Background: 10 ea. 3 1/2" Width of Fabric Strips
Subcut these into 100 ea. 3 1/2" Squares

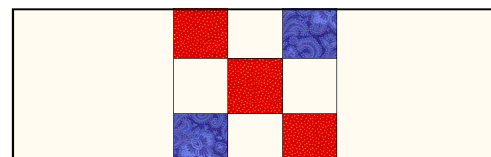
Assembly:

1. Using one Block C and one Block D AND carefully matching their orientation as at right, stitch a background square between the two blocks to make a Row 1 unit. The row should measure 3 1/2" X 9 1/2". Make 25 Row 1 units.
2. Using one Block A AND carefully matching orientation as at right, stitch a background square on both sides of the block to make a Row 2 unit. The row should measure 3 1/2" X 9 1/2". Make 25 Row 2 units.
3. Using one Block D and one Block B AND carefully matching their orientation as at right, stitch a background square between the two blocks to make a Row 3 unit. The row should measure 3 1/2" X 9 1/2". Make 25 Row 3 units.
4. Again watching orientation as at right, stitch together a Nostalgic 9 In 9 block using one of each row 1, 2 and 3. The block should measure 9 1/2" square. Make 25 Nostalgic 9 In 9 blocks.

Next week we will set the blocks together with alternate blocks.



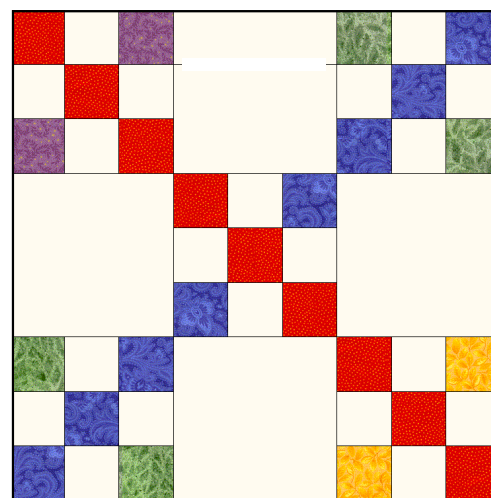
Block C Background Block D
