

Nostalgic Nine In Nine Quilt 2014

Week 6

Setting The Blocks Together

Cutting:

From Background:

6 ea. 9 1/2" Width of Fabric Strips

From these sub-cut 24 ea. 9 1/2" squares

Assembly:

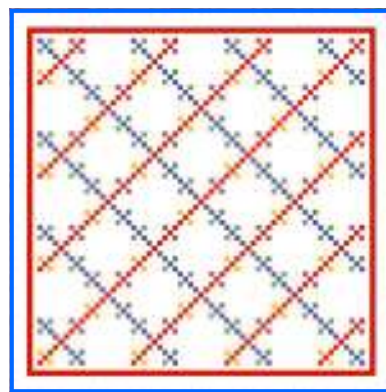
1. Stitch together a Nostalgic 9 In 9 block and a 9 1/2" background square, matching orientation as at right. In the sample, the purple and red 9-Patch is always in the upper left corner. Make 21 pairs.

2. **Row A:** Stitch three pairs together as at right. Add another Nostalgic 9 In 9 Block at the end as shown to complete a Row A. Make four Row As.

3. **Row B:** Stitch three pairs together as above. But this time add a 9 1/2" Background to the start of the Row. Make three Row Bs.

4. Stitch a Row A and a Row B together. Make three Row Pairs.

5. Stitch the three Row Pairs together as shown watching orientation. Add the final Row A to the bottom to complete the quilt center.

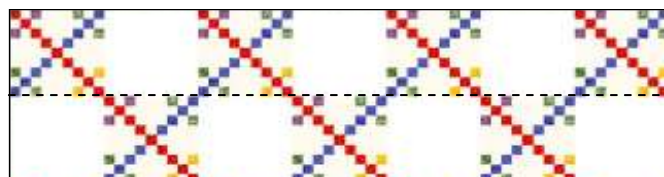

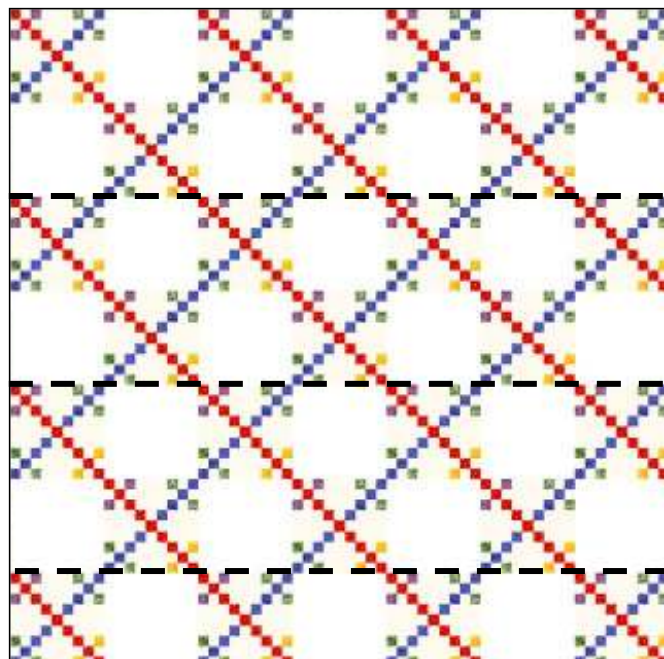
2. Make 4 Row As
