## States of Modern: Iowa

I think of Iowa, I think of agriculture. So our modern Iowa block mixes little bit of the Iowa flag and my modern, minimalist interpretation of an Iowa cornfield.

Cutting:


Red: 1 ea.
Blue: 1 ea.
Green: 4 ea.
Gold: 3 ea.
White: 2 ea.

2" x 9 1/2" strip
$2^{\prime \prime} \times 91 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip
$11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips
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## Assembly:

1. Stitch together three pairs of strips (one green, one gold) along their long edge as shown.
2. Stitch the green-gold units together into a single unit with the strips alternating green-gold-green-gold-greengold. Add a final green strip to the gold edge as shown. 3. Add a white strip to the top and bottom of the greengold unit from step 2 as shown. Unit should measure 6 1/2" X 9 1/2".
3. Add the blue strip to left-hand side and the red strip to the right hand side as shown to complete your block. Completed block should measure $91 / 2 \times 91 / 2^{\prime \prime}$.
