# Postage Stamp Pillow 

## 10"X 18 " Finished from LynBrown.com

## Cutting:

Various Medium and Dark Prints: 136 ea. 1 1/2" squares White: 2 ea. $11 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ x $141 / 2^{\prime \prime}$

2 \text { ea. } 1 \text { 1/2" x } 8 \text { 1/2" }
$$

## Assembly:

1. Stitch all the squares into 68 random pairs. From the pairs, make 21 only 4 -Patches as shown. Also make 2 pieced strips 8 pairs ( $161 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ ) long and 2 pieced strips 5 pairs ( $101 / 2$ long). Set pieced strips aside.
2. Stitch together 3 rows of 7 ea. 4 - Patches. Stitch the rows together to make center section that has 21 ea .4 -Patches or 84 patches.
3. Add the $141 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ white strips to top and bottom of center section. Next add $81 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ white strips to sides of center section.
4. Complete the pillow top by adding the $161 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ pieced strips to top and bottom and then the $101 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ pieced strips to the sides.


Make 68 Random


Make 21 ONLY
6. Layer with backing and batting (11 X 19). Quilt as desired.

## Pillow Cover Assembly:

1. Crease the Background in half both lengthwise and crosswise. Layout your design centered on the Background using the creases as a guide. Fuse in place. These will be stitched down with intense quilting.
2. Layer Background, Batting and Backing. Quilt as desired. I quilted lines randomly spaced about $1 / 4$ " apart. Trim

Make 2 ea. 16 square pieced strips


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2. Turn and press. Stuff. Hand stitch opening close.
